NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The following information was released by the White House Press Office on December 3, 4, and 5, 1975:

1. The President has accepted the resignation of Charles R. Work as Deputy Administrator for the Administration of the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration effective November 21, 1975. (POSTING, DECEMBER 3, 1975)
2. Intention to nominate William J. Porter, of Massachusetts, to be Ambassador to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. He will succeed James E. Akins who has resigned. Since March 1974, Ambassador Porter has been Ambassador to Canada. (RELEASE, DECEMBER 4, 1975)
3. Text of Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger's Press Conference, Peking, People's Republic of China. (RELEASE DECEMBER 5, 1975)
4. Intention to nominate J. Charles Partee, of Great Falls, Virginia, to be a member of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System. (RELEASE, DECEMBER 5, 1975)
5. Intention to nominate Mrs. Betty Jo Christian to be an Interstate Commerce Commissioner. (RELEASE, DECEMBER 5, 1975)
