The President today announced his intention to nominate Robert E. Lee, of Denver, Colorado, to be a member of the Foreign Claims Settlement Commission of the United States for a term of three years. He will succeed Lyle S. Garlock who resigned effective July 30, 1975. Mr. Lee is the owner of a consulting firm in Denver, Colorado.

Born in Topeka, Kansas, March 15, 1914, Mr. Lee attended Washburn College. He also did additional work toward an LL.D. degree.

Mr. Lee was a real estate broker beginning in 1940 and served on the Board of Realtors in the State of Colorado from 1950 to 1960.

Mr. Lee is married to the former Elizabeth Johnston and they have two sons and a daughter.
