REMARKS OF
THE HONORABLE HENRY A. KISSINGER
SECRETARY OF STATE
UPON DEPARTURE FROM ORLY AIRPORT
PARIS
FEBRUARY 19, 1975

Secretary Kissinger:

The meetings with the Foreign Minister and the President were very satisfactory. We reviewed the whole range of issues that concern the U.S. and France, which is another way of saying we reviewed the world situation. We spoke, of course, about the Middle East, the energy problem, and the proposed conference between consumers and producers, toward which good progress is being made, and all of these talks were conducted in an atmosphere of cordiality, friendship and cooperation. I'd like to thank the President and the Foreign Minister for the very warm and cordial reception that I received.
