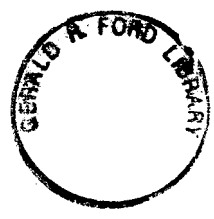
STATEMENT BY
THE HONORABLE HENRY A. KISSINGER
SECRETARY OF STATE
UPON ARRIVAL AT ORLY AIRPORT
PARIS, FRANCE
DECEMBER 15, 1975

SECRETARY KISSINGER: Good evening. We have two international problems or two major international problems: the problem of peace and war, which concerns primarily East-West relations, and the problem of development and social justice, which deals primarily with North-South issues.

The conference that I am attending here will attempt to deal with the problem of the economic development of the entire world: the problem of social justice.

The United States is coming to it in a cooperative spirit and the realization that our economies are all inter-dependent and that our destinies are inter-linked. We will deal with it with a sense of responsibility and attempt to shape a better future, and we hope that our colleagues will approach it with the same attitude. Thank you.
