AS MANY OF YOU KNOW, I ALWAYS WELCOME THE OPPORTUNITY

FOLKS. BUT, THIS IS A SPECIAL OCCASION -- I DARE SAY, A HIS

PIONEERS WHOSE DEEDS HAVE HAD TREMENDOUS, POSITIVE, AND
LASTING EFFECT ON THE LIVES OF THE MULTITUDES -- SUCH PIONEERS

JEAN DuSABLE, THE FUR-TRAPPER AND MERCHANT-TRADER WHO FOUNDED THE GREAT CITY OF CHICAGO (THAT IS A LITTLE-KNOWN PART OF OUR BLACK HISTORY);

THOSE 27 BLACK LATINS WHO HELPED THE GREAT CITY OF LOS

ANGELES;

AND THE LATE C.C. SPAULDING, A ONE-TIME BARBER WHO HELPED FOUND -- AND WHO FOR MANY YEARS HEADED -- THE LARGEST BLACK BUSINESS IN AMERICA, THE NORTH CAROLINA MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY.



WHEN I CONSIDER THE IMPORTANCE AND MAGNITUDE OF SOUL
CITY, I AM REMINDED OF MANY GREAT BLACKS WHO DREAMED BIG
DREAMS AND MADE THOSE DREAMS COME TRUE. SOUL CITY IS A
DREAM COME TRUE. THE RAMIFICATIONS OF THIS DREAM COULD HAVE
A PROFOUND EFFECT ON THE BLACK COMMUNITIES OF THIS NATION,
ON THE WHOLE OF AMERICA ITSELF, FOR WHAT IT MEANS.

WHAT IT MEANS IS THAT BLACKS ARE NOW GETTING INTO THE

HAVE IT IN ORDER TO SURVIVE, BUT WE ARE TRYING TO BREAK THE

CYCLES OF POVERTY AND THEY CANNOT BE BROKEN IF WE ARE HELD

IN BONDAGE AS THE PRESENT WELFARE SYSTEM HAS DONE AND STILL

DOES.



SOUL CITY REPRESENTS TO ME--AND TO MILLIONS OF BLACKS-ONE WAY, ONE AVENUE, THROUGH WHICH WE CAN BREAK OUT OF,
BREAK AWAY FROM, THE STATE OF BONDAGE, THE STATE OF POVERTY,
WHICH IS THE PURGATORY OF FAILURE, DESPAIR, SICKNESS, AND
DEATH FOR SO MANY OF OUR PEOPLE--RIGHT HERE IN WARREN COUNTY,
NORTH CAROLINA, AND THROUGHOUT MANY CITIES, COUNTIES, AND
STATES OF OUR NATION.

ONE TO GO BEYOND THE CALL OF DUTY, WHICH ENABLES ONE TO GO

THAT SECOND MILE, WHICH ENABLES ONE TO HURDLE THE OBSTACLES AND ROADBLOCKS WHICH MEN WITH GREAT, NEW IDEAS ALWAYS FACE.

I WILL NOT DWELL TONIGHT ON THE ROADBLOCKS TO SOUL CITY.

THAT WOULD, PERHAPS, BE POINTLESS. BUT IT IS NEVERTHELESS

TRUE THAT MANY PEOPLE HERE IN THIS COUNTY AND STATE HAVE

FOUGHT SOUL CITY.

THE MORE IMPORTANT TRUTH, HOWEVER, IS THAT FLOYD McKISSICK, LIKE THE CHAMPION ATHLETE, COMES TO WIN. AND, WIN HE DOES.

I CAN BELIEVE HIM WHEN HE PROJECTS FOR SOUL CITY IN 30

YEARS A POPULATION OF 44,000, BOOMING INDUSTRY AND BUSINESS,

GOOD HOMES AND SCHOOLS AND HEALTH FACILITIES AND RECREATIONAL

FACILITIES AND STREETS--A CITY, IN SHORT, WHICH ITS PEOPLE WILL



BE PROUD OF -- A CITY WHICH HAS BECOME A MODEL FOR AMERICA.

I CAN ENVISION SOUL CITY AS A MODEL BY WHICH MANY OF THE PROBLEMS OF URBAN DECAY ARE SOLVED--ESPECIALLY THAT PROBLEM OF THE NORTH CAROLINIAN OR THE SOUTH CAROLINIAN OR THE ALABAMAN WHO FLEES HOME BECAUSE OF IMPOVERISHED CONDITIONS ONLY TO WIND UP IN THE NORTH OR MIDWEST IN CRUMBLING, INNER-CITY GHETTOS.

WHEN MORE SOUL CITIES ARE BUILT, THE DISTANT "PASTURE"
IN ANOTHER STATE WILL NOT APPEAR TO BE GREENER THAN THE
VERDANT PASTURE OF HOME.

I FEEL THAT, AS A RACE, WE TEND SOMETIMES TO DWELL TOO
LONG, TO EXPEND TOO MUCH ENERGY, ON OBSTACLES, REAL OR
FANCIED, AND NOT ENOUGH ON DOING THE JOB THAT HAS TO BE DONE.



AN EXPLANATION DOES NOT MAKE A RIGHT OUT OF A WRONG.

THE TRUTH IS THAT IT IS HUMAN NATURE AT WORK WHEN PEOPLE

REACT ADVERSELY TO GREAT, NEW IDEAS. BUT ONE CANNOT LET

NEGATIVE PEOPLE GET HIM DOWN.

THE CHAMPION KEEPS ON SWINGING, PLUNGING, FIGHTING. AND,

WE LIKE TO FEEL THAT WE ARE SPIRITUAL PARTNERS IN SOUL CITY AS WELL AS FINANCIAL SUPPORTERS.

WHEN I SAY "WE," I AM TALKING ABOUT PRESIDENT NIXON;

I AM TALKING ABOUT THE WHITE HOUSE;

I AM TALKING ABOUT THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT;

I AM TALKING ABOUT OTHER DEPARTMENTS OF THE U.S. GOVERN-MENT WHICH ARE PERTINENT TO THE BUILDING OF SOUL CITY.



AND, WHILE I AM ON THE SUBJECT OF THE NIXON ADMINISTRATION,
PLEASE PERMIT ME TO INFORM YOU AS TO SOME OTHERS OF THE
BLACK PROJECTS WE ARE ENGAGED IN RIGHT NOW.

JUST TODAY, CHARLES WALKER, UNDER SECRETARY OF THE
UNITED STATES TREASURY DEPARTMENT, ANNOUNCED THAT DEPOSITS
IN BLACK BANKS, STIMULATED BY OUR PROGRAM TO HELP THOSE
INSTITUTIONS, NOW AMOUNT TO MORE THAN \$800 MILLION. BEFORE

IF THERE ARE ANY BLACK BANKERS IN THE AUDIENCE TONIGHT,
THEY MAY CHECK IT OUT. IN FACT, ANYONE CAN VISIT ANY BLACK
BANK AND HAVE THESE FACTS SUBSTANTIATED.



THE TRUTH IS THAT BLACK FOLKS NEVER HAVE HAD THIS KIND
OF IN-PUT IN AMERICA AT ANY PREVIOUS TIME.

IF YOU CALL THIS CONSERVATIVE, WE NEED MORE OF IT. THIS

IS THE ONLY THING WHICH WILL GET US OVER. THE SYSTEM WILL

NOT CHANGE BY ITSELF. WE MUST GET IN THERE AND WORK WITH IT

TO EFFECT WHATEVER CHANGES ARE NECESSARY TO HELP OUR

PEOPLE.

THE NIXON ADMINISTRATION SUPPORTS BLACK COLLEGES.

NORTH CAROLINA, HAVING MORE BLACK COLLEGES THAN ANY OTHER.

STATE, IS ONE OF THE PRIME BENEFICIARIES OF THIS COMMITMENT.



INSTEAD OF A COMMITMENT TO CLOSE UP BLACK COLLEGES,

AS MANY OF OUR "LIBERAL FRIENDS," QUOTE, UNQUOTE, HAVE

WANTED TO DO, WE NOW HAVE A COMMITMENT TO REVITALIZE THE

BLACK COLLEGES.

WE ARE NOT TALKING ABOUT REVITALIZING BLACK COLLEGES

FOR THE PURPOSE OF SEGREGATION BUT REVITALIZING THEM WITH

THE KNOWLEDGE THAT WE SHOULD KEEP OPEN EVERY COLLEGE DOOR

POSSIBLE FOR ALL PEOPLE, BLACK AND WHITE.

IN THE CONTEXT OF SOUL CITY, I HAVE SPOKEN ABOUT MINORITY ENTERPRISE.

WELL, IN PREVIOUS YEARS, WE HAVE HAD A LOT OF TALK ABOUT
MINORITY ENTERPRISE -- BUT THERE HAS BEEN VERY LITTLE ACTION
ON IT -- VERY LITTLE GOVERNMENTAL HELP FOR IT.

A FEW YEARS AGO, SOMEONE SUGGESTED THAT WHAT WE NEEDED TO DO WAS ESTABLISH 10,000 NEW BLACK BUSINESSES EACH YEAR FOR

THE NEXT 10 YEARS. BUT THE PROBLEM WAS THAT THE PERSON
WHO MADE THIS SUGGESTION DIDN'T KNOW ANYTHING ABOUT BLACK
BUSINESS. HE HAD NO COMMITMENT TO BLACK BUSINESS. HE WAS
MERELY TRYING TO CATCH THE EYE OF THE PRESS.

PRIOR TO THIS ADMINISTRATION, THE MOST EVER SPENT BY

THE GOVERNMENT ON BEHALF OF BLACK BUSINESS WAS \$200 MILLION

IN FOUR YEARS. NOW, MORE THAN \$800 MILLION IS BUDGETED FOR

THIS PROGRAM IN FISCAL YEAR 1973.

AMONG THE MANY OTHER PROGRAMS THIS ADMINISTRATION HAS

INITIATED ON BEHALF OF BLACK AMERICANS IS THE PROGRAM TO

FIGHT SICKLE CELL ANEMIA. ALTHOUGH BLACKS HAVE SUFFERED

FROM THIS DREADED DISEASE FOR 500 YEARS, NO GOVERNMENTAL

EFFORT WAS MADE TO COMBAT IT PRIOR TO THE NIXON ADMINISTRATION.



THE KEY TO SUCCESS IN THIS FIGHT IS MONEY. THE PRESIDENT

HAS ALLOCATED FUNDS TO FIGHT SICKLE CELL ANEMIA. YESTERDAY,

IN FACT, GRANTS TOTALING \$9 MILLION WERE MADE FOR THE

PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING RESEARCH, TREATMENT, AND EDUCATIONAL

CENTERS AROUND THE COUNTRY. THOSE GRANTS ARE FOR THE

WHAT ARE WE EDUCATING OUR KIDS FOR?



THE <u>FUTURE</u> RESTS ON YOUNG PEOPLE--HOW WE RELATE TO THEM; HOW WE RESPOND TO THEIR NEEDS.

IT IS VITALLY IMPORTANT THAT WE EDUCATE OUR KIDS SO THAT
THEY CAN FUNCTION IN TOP LEVEL GOVERNMENT JOBS, SO THEY
CAN FUNCTION WHERE THE ACTION IS, SO THEY CAN HELP THEIR
PEOPLE--SO THEY CAN HELP THE POOR AND THE DISADVANTAGED.

MANY OF THE CASES WHICH DETERMINE THE COURSE OF MILLIONS

OF YOUNG MEN'S LIVES IN THIS COUNTRY;

HAVING FOR THE FIRST TIME 10 GENERAL OFFICERS IN OUR ARMED FORCES--INSTEAD OF ONE BLACK GENERAL--WITH OPPORTUNITIES TO MOVE AHEAD;

HAVING A CIVIL RIGHTS ENFORCEMENT BUDGET OF MORE THAN \$600 MILLION INSTEAD OF \$75 MILLION THREE AND A HALF YEARS AGO.

THIS IS WHAT BEING ON THE CASE MEANS TO ME. FOR BLACK PEOPLE IN AMERICA, THIS IS WHAT IT HAS TO MEAN.



OF COURSE IT IS TRUE THAT NOT ENOUGH HAS BEEN DONE. NOT ENOUGH WILL HAVE BEEN DONE UNTIL THERE ARE NO MORE POOR PEOPLE IN AMERICA, UNTIL THERE IS NO MORE RACISM, UNTIL THERE IS NO MORE DISCRIMINATION--UNTIL IT IS NO LONGER THE PRACTICE TO HIRE BLACKS LAST AND FIRE THEM FIRST.

I AM NOT HERE TO TELL YOU THAT ENOUGH HAS BEEN DONE.

WHAT I AM SAYING IS THAT DESPITE ALL THAT HAS BEEN SAID ABOUT

THE NIXON ADMINISTRATION--THAT THIS ADMINISTRATION IS ANTI
POOR AND ANTI-BLACK, THAT THE PRESIDENT DOESN'T CARE-
DESPITE THE HOSTILE ATTITUDES OF MANY BLACKS AROUND THE

NATION. . . .

DO IT THIS WAY:

TAKE ALL THE FACTS, NOT RHETORIC, NOT SPEECHES. . .



TAKE ALL THE FACTS ABOUT WHAT IS BEING DONE AND WEIGH

IS THAT FAIR ENOUGH?

I BELIEVE THIS ADMINISTRATION HAS PROVEN IT CARES ABOUT BLACKS. IN ALL TRUTH, THOUGH, I SOMETIMES WONDER WHETHER THE PROBLEM IS THAT BLACKS ARE ANTI-NIXON INSTEAD OF THE OTHER WAY AROUND. I DO KNOW, AS A RESULT OF WORKING WITH HIM, THAT PRESIDENT NIXON CARES.

WE HAVE DONE THIS DESPITE THE FACT THAT THE PRESIDENT RECEIVED VERY FEW BLACK VOTES IN 1968.

JUST ON THE BASIS OF BEING FAIR, WHICH BLACK PEOPLE ASK
OF EVERYONE ELSE, I THINK HE DESERVES MORE CREDIT FOR
WHAT HE HAS DONE THAN THOSE WHO WROTE US OUT A CHECK OF
PROMISES WHICH BOUNCED EVERY FOUR YEARS.

HE HAS WRITTEN A CHECK AND THAT CHECK IS NOW BEING

CASHED IN THE FIGHT AGAINST SICKLE CELL ANEMIA, IN SUPPORT

OF BLACK COLLEGES, IN SUPPORT OF BLACK BUSINESSES, IN FOOD

PROGRAMS FOR THE POOR, AND IN MANY OTHER AREAS.

BLACKS PREVIOUSLY HAVE COME UP WITH CHECKS WHERE,

AFTER TWO YEARS OR FOUR YEARS, THE CHECKS HAVE BEEN

RETURNED STAMPED "INSUFFICIENT FUNDS." BUT NOW THE CHECKS

ARE BEING CASHED AND THERE ARE SUFFICIENT FUNDS IN THE BANK

TO COVER THEM.

THERE IS EVIDENCE OF THE FACT THAT PRESIDENT NIXON

CARES RIGHT HERE IN SOUL CITY. THERE WILL BE A GREAT DEAL

MORE EVIDENCE OF IT HERE IN SOUL CITY, IN WATTS, IN ROBBINS,

ILLINOIS, IN BLACK AREAS ALL OVER AMERICA.

WE MUST STOP BEING DISHONEST WITH OUR PEOPLE. WE MUST
TELL THEM THE TRUTH. ALL TOO MANY OF OUR LEADERSHIP HAVE
BEEN DISHONEST WITH OUR PEOPLE--TELLING THEM ONLY ENOUGH
OF THE TRUTH TO MAKE WHATEVER POINT THEY HAVE WANTED TO
MAKE FOR THEIR OWN SELFISH PURPOSES. NEVER BEFORE IN OUR

WE'VE GOT TO RID OF SLUM LANDLORDS, NOT PROTECT THEM.

WE MUST RUN THE MUGGERS AND THE DOPE DEALERS AND THE

MURDERERS AND THE ROBBERS OUT OF BLACK NEIGHBORHOODS.

BLACK PEOPLE MUST MOBILIZE AS A FORCE IN THIS COUNTRY

IN ORDER TO DEAL WITH OUR PROBLEMS--AND, IT SEEMS TO ME,

THE PEOPLE KNOW ACTUALLY KNOW MORE ABOUT WHAT SHOULD BE

DONE THAN OUR "LEADERS," QUOTE, UNQUOTE.

THEY KNOW MORE ABOUT THE PROBLEMS OF CRIME AND POVERTY,

OF BAD HOUSING AND OTHER FORMS OF DISCRIMINATION; THEY

KNOW WHAT IT IS LIKE TO BE THE LAST HIRED AND THE FIRST FIRED--
WHILE SO MANY OF OUR SELF-PROCLAIMED AND HIGHLY-PUBLICIZED

"LEADERS," QUOTE, UNQUOTE, ARE LIVING HIGH ON THE HOG AS A RESULT OF THEIR EXPLOITATION OF THEIR OWN PEOPLE.

WE MUST CONCENTRATE MORE OF OUR EFFORTS ON SOLVING
OUR DAY-TO-DAY, SUBSTANTIVE PROBLEMS, WE MUST CONCENTRATE
MORE ON THESE PROBLEMS THAN ON CONFRONTATION OR RACIAL
SEPARATION OR OTHER EXOTIC EXPERIMENTS.

W.C. HANDY, THE LATE, GREAT MUSICAL COMPOSER, ONCE
SAID THAT LIFE IS SOMETHING LIKE A TRUMPET. IF YOU DON'T PUT
ANYTHING INTO IT, YOU DON'T GET ANYTHING OUT OF IT.

WE MUST BEGIN NOW TO PUT SOMETHING--A GOOD DEAL MORE-INTO OUR INSTITUTIONS. . . . NOT JUST FOR THE SAKE OF GETTING
SOMETHING OUT OF THEM, BUT FOR THE SAKE OF OUR VERY SURVIVAL.

THE KIND OF LEADERSHIP WE NEED REQUIRES BRAINS AND HARD,
UNGLAMOROUS WORK. IT REQUIRES AN UNDERSTANDING OF HUMAN
NATURE. IT REQUIRES MUCH MORE THAN ORATORICAL EXCELLENCE.

IT MUST BE CAPABLE OF LOOKING AT OUR BROTHERIN THE GHETTO, UNDERSTANDING HIS DIMMING HOPE, AND REACHING OUT TO GIVE HIM A HELPING HAND.

WE NEED MORE BLACK LEADERS LIKE FLOYD McKISSICK.

NOT ONLY DOES HE POSSESS ALL THE QUALITIES I HAVE JUST MENTIONED, HE IS A MAN WHO UNDERSTANDS THE TRUTH OF W.C. HANDY'S PARABLE.
