OPPORTUNITY TO JOIN YOU TONIGHT...TO BE ON FAMILIAR TURF....

TO RETURN TO THE STATE WHERE MY GRANDFATHER---THE REV.

WILLIAM ALEXANDER SCOTT--GOT HIS START AS A PRINTER
PREACHER IN EDWARDS, MISSISSIPPI.

I KNOW THIS LAND AS YOU KNOW IT. I HAVE SEEN THE SORROW

AND HEARTACHE, AS A NEWSMAN I WITNESSED SOME OF THE

PROBLEMS WE CAME TO GRIPS WITHIN THE TURBULENT 60'S. BUT

I ALSO KNOW SOMETHING ABOUT THE PROGRESS THAT WE HAVE MADE

OF BLACK ELECTED OFFICIALS IN THE COUNTRY. IN OTHER WORDS,

SAYING: "BOB STRAUSS, THE DEMOCRATIC NATIONAL CHAIRMAN,

IS STILL AT IT." I ASKED: "WHAT DO YOU MEAN?" THE SECRETARY

SAID: "OH, HE'S STILL OUT SPEAKING TO LARGE GROUPS.... NOT

AUDIENCES.... DEMOCRAT CANDIDATES FOR PRESIDENT"!

SERIOUSLY, I AM DELIGHTED TO BE HERE IN JACKSON TO JOIN
ALL OF YOU IN PAYING TRIBUTE TO MEL JENNINGS--OUR NFXT

I SEE IN YOU AMERICA SINGING A BEAUTIFUL SONG OF HUMAN PROGRESS. I SEE AN EXPERIMENT IN SELF-GOVERNMENT THAT HAS WORKED SUPERBLY FOR ALMOST 200 YEARS FOR MOST AMERICANS--



NOW I SEETHAT SAME GOVERNMENT BEGINNING TO WORK FOR BLACK AMERICANS, TOO. AND THIS WILL REMAIN TRUE AS LONG AS WE BELIEVE IN IT AND WORK TO KEEP IT THAT WAY. SO, I SAY TO YOU TONIGHT LET US BUILD BRIDGES TO HUMAN DIGNITY AND HUMAN PROGRESS THROUGH THE POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC PROCESS.

EVERY ETHNIC GROUP THAT HAS BEEN ABLE TO MAKE IT INTO

THE SO-CALLED AMERICAN MELTING POT HAS DONE IT BY GOING

THE ECONOMIC AND POLITICAL ROUTE. I SAY IT WILL BE NO DIFFERENT

FOR BLACK AMERICANS.

TONIGHT, I WOULD LIKE TO CONCENTRATE ON POLITICS. I
WOULD LIKE TO JOIN FORCES WITH MEL JENNINGS. HE HAS JOINED
THE BATTLE. HE KNOWS WHERE IT'S AT. WE HAVE GOT TO GIVE HIM
OUR SUPPORT. LET HIM WORK FOR US TO MAKE THE AMERICAN DREAM
A REALITY FOR US.

I AM FREQUENTLY ASKED AROUND THE COUNTRY, "IS THE CIVIL RIGHTS MOVEMENT DEAD?" MY CONSISTENT ANSWER IS A LOUD NO.

WHAT HAS HAPPENED IS SIMPLY THIS -- THE LAWS HAVE CAUGHT UP

WITH OUR CONSCIENCE. WHAT REMAINS IS TO GIVE LIFE TO
WHAT IS THE LAW: TO INSURE AT LAST THAT AS ALL ARE BORN EQUAL
IN DIGNITY BEFORE GOD, ALL ARE BORN EQUAL IN DIGNITY BEFORE
MAN.

WHAT WE MUST DO IS REDUCE THE NOISE LEVEL... REDUCE THE RHETORIC... MOVE PAST THE OLD CIVIL RIGHTS... BRIDGE THE GAP BETWEEN FREEDOM AND DIGNITY, BETWEEN PROMISE AND FULFILLMENT.

THE ERA OF CONFRONTATION IN THE 60'S HAS BEEN REPLACED WITH A FAR LESS DRAMATIC, BUT, I BELIEVE, A MORE DIFFICULT BUT PRODUCTIVE IMMEDIATE AND LONG RANGE PROGRAM.

MINORITIES ARE NOW BEGINNING TO CONCENTRATE ON THE POLITICAL APPROACH...PLACING GREATER EMPHASIS ON REGISTRATION PROGRAMS, DEFINING POLITICAL ISSUES AND APPROACHING.

THE VOTING BOOTH IN LARGER NUMBERS.

THE SIXTIES CONSTITUTED AN EXAMINATION OF THE WRONGS:

THE SEVENTIES AN APPLICATION OF THE REMEDIES. DEALING WITH

THESE QUESTIONS REQUIRES SCALPEL AND SUTURES, NOT THE

BOILING CAULDRON OF A FEW YEARS AGO.

THIS IS THE WORK THAT IS NOW UNDERWAY. IT IS THE WORK
THAT LOGICALLY FOLLOWS THE SYMBOLIC AND LEGISLATIVE GAINS
MADE BEFORE. IT IS THE PAYOFF ON THOSE GAINS. WHILE I THINK
WE MUST AGREE THAT PROGRESS HAS BEEN MADE, I WOULD ADD
THAT THERE CAN NEVER BE ENOUGH PROGRESS UNTIL ALL AMERICANS
ARE ASSURED OF PARITY ACROSS THE BOARD.

SOMETIMES IT'S EVEN HARD FOR STUDENTS OF RACE RELATIONS

TO UNDERSTAND THE CIVIL RIGHTS MOVEMENT BECAUSE WE ARE TALKING

ABOUT NEW TACTICS IN THE 70'S TO RESOLVE ADDITIONAL PROBLEMS

CREATED BY PROGRESS MADE DURING THE PAST DECADE. MOST OF

THE SYMBOLIC, EARLY GAINS STEMMING FROM CIVIL CONFRONTATION

ARE BEHIND US. WHAT REMAINS IS THE LESS SPECTACULAR TASK OF

RESOLVING THE MORE COMPLEX AND DIFFICULT ISSUES AHEAD IN THE

FIELD OF HUMAN RIGHTS AS WELL AS MINORITY RIGHTS. IT IS, IN

MY VIEW, INDEED A SIGN OF MATURITY THAT IN TEN YEARS CIVIL

RIGHTS ENFORCEMENT HAS BECOME A PART OF THE BASIC FABRIC OF

AMERICAN LIFE.

OURSELVES FROM THE MENTAL CHAINS OF SLAVERY AND SECOND-CLASS CITIZENSHIP. THROUGH PLOOD, SWEAT AND TEARS WE PRESSED OUR BILL OF PARTICULARS REFORE THE AMERICAN PUBLIC WITH SIT-INS, JAIL-INS AND COUNTLESS OTHER FORMS OF MASS PROTEST.

NOW THE TACTICS HAVE CHANGED. MOST OF THE LAWS ARE

NOW ON THE BOOKS. WE HAVE PUBLIC ACCOMODATIONS AND

VOTING RIGHTS LAWS. WE REALIZED IN THE 60'S THAT IT'S NOT

ENOUGH TO HAVE ACCESS. WE ARE NOW ENGAGED IN LESS

DRAWATIC INVOLVEMENT. WE WANT TO OWN SOME OF THOSE

LUNCH COUNTERS, HOTELS AND GAIN SOME OF THE GOVERNMENT

AND PRIVATE SECTOR CONTRACTS. WE ARE FINALLY TALKING

ABOUT BECOMING PRODUCERS AS OPPOSED TO AGE-OLD CONSUMERS

IN THIS GREAT CAPITALISTIC DEMOCRATIC SOCIETY. WE ARE



AMERICAN PIE. NOW THAT WE HAVE MADE IT INSIDE THE FACILITY, WE NOW WANT A PIECE OF THE ACTION...AND RIGHTLY SO-- THIS IS WHAT THE AMERICAN SYSTEM IS ALL ABOUT.

THE MOMENTUM OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS MOVEMENT IS

CONTINUING, EXPANDING, AND ACHIEVING GREATER CONCRETE

SUCCESSES IN BOTH OLD AND NEW AREAS OF ENDEAVOR.

SO WHERE DO WE GO FROM HERE TO MAKE EQUALITY A
REALITY FOR ALL AMERICANS? FIRST, I THINK, WE MUST
ACKNOWLEDGE CERTAIN TRUTHS.

THE BLACK VOTE TODAY IS THE LEAST EFFECTIVE VOTE IN

AMERICA. WE HAVE EARNED THE RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE IN

THE POLITICAL ARENA--THROUGH BLOOD, SWEAT AND TEARS--IN

THE SIXTIES, BUT WE HAVE NOT LEARNED TO PARTICIPATE TOO

WISELY.

HERE'S THE SITUATION TODAY--IN JUNE OF 1975. A

CANDIDATE CAN ANNOUNCE FOR OFFICE AND BEFORE HE MAKES HIS

FIRST CAMPAIGN SPEECH--IF HE HAPPENS TO BE A DEMOCRAT-
HE KNOWS THAT HE HAS FROM 70 TO 80 PERCENT OF THE BLACK VOTE

IN HIS HIP POCKET. HOW CAN AN INDIVIDUAL OR A GROUP OF

PEOPLE GAIN COMMITMENTS FROM POLITICANS WHEN THE POLITICANS

KNOW THAT THEY HAVE THAT INDIVIDUAL OR GROUP'S VOTES AT THE

OUTSET?

WE, AS A RACIAL MINORITY, HAVE GOT TO STOP ALLOWING OURSELVES TO BE TAKEN FOR GRANTED--BY THE DEMOCRATS.

AN INDICATION OF HOW STRONGLY I FEEL ABOUT THE TWO-PARTY SYSTEM IS SIMPLY THIS: IF 70 TO 80 PERCENT OF BLACK AMERICANS WERE VOTING THE REPUBLICAN LINE TODAY, I WOULD SWITCH TO THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY.

LET ME SAY SOMETHING TO YOU ABOUT A SURE BET. PRESIDENT FORD INTENDS TO SEFK THE NOMINATION OF THE REPUBLICAN PARTY AS ITS CANDIDATE IN 1976. HE INTENDS TO RUN FOR PRESIDENT AND HE INTENDS TO WIN.

NOW IT COULD BE ARGUED THAT, BECAUSE OUR NATIONAL PROBLEMS ARE SO SERIOUS, WE SHOULD NOT BE WASTING TIME ON THE PROBLEMS OF OUR PARTY--OR ANY PARTY.

YET IT IS PRECISELY BECAUSE OF OUR NATIONAL PROBLEMS

THAT IT IS ESSENTIAL TO LOOK TO OUR PARTY AND ITS REVITALIZATION EVERYWHERE.

TO CARRY OUT OUR DETERMINATION TO MAKE SURE THAT

REPUBLICANS ARE ON THE RISE, WE ARE GOING TO HAVE TO

MAKE SOME FUNDAMENTAL CHANGES IN OUR POLITICAL THINKING.

AS A STARTER, WE MUST DISCARD THE ATTITUDE OF EXCLUSIVENESS
THAT HAS KEPT THE REPUBLICAN PARTY'S DOOR CLOSED TOO OFTEN
WHILE WE GIVE SPEECHES ABOUT KEEPING IT OPEN.

WE MUST ERECT A TENT THAT IS BIG ENOUGH FOR ALL WHO CARE

ABOUT THIS GREAT COUNTRY AND BELIEVE IN THE REPUBLICAN PARTY

ENOUGH TO WORK THROUGH IT FOR COMMON GOALS.



WE MUST BE PREPARED TO OVERCOME THE CYNICISM OF

VOTERS WITH CANDIDATES OF OUTSTANDING ABILITY AND ROCK-HARD

INTEGRITY. PEOPLE LIKE MELVIN JENNINGS.

I AM CONVINCED THAT THE POLITICAL LANDSCAPE--IN THE
