DEAR MH, PRIME MINISTER : DUR TWO GOVERNMENTS ARE NOW WORKING WITH THE OTHER MEMBERS OF THE INTERNATIONAL ENERGY AGENCY TO COMPLETE AN OVERALL PRAMEMORK OF CONSUMER COUNTRY COOPERATION ON FINANCIAL SOLIDARITY, ENERGY CONSERVATION AND THE ACCELERATED DEVELOPMENT OF NEW ENERGY SUPPLIED. WE HAVE ALREADY REACHED AGREEMENTS ON THE FIRST THO OF THESE. WE MUST NOW COMPLETE OUR OVERALL COOPERATIVE EFFORTS WITH BASIC UNDERSTANDINGS ON OUR APPROACH TO ACCELERATED DEVELOPMENT.

AS I SEE IT, OUR COMMON POLICY ON ACCELERATED DEVELOPMENT SHOULD FULFILL THE FOLLOWING REGULREMENTS. IT SHOULD ASSURE RAPID DEVELOPMENT OF AVAILABLE ENERGY OPPORTUNITIES IN THE CONSUMING COUNTRIES WITHOUT GIVING INVESTORS A

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WHOLLY RISK-FREE OPPORTUNITY, IT SHOULD ALLOW FOR THE DIVERSITY IN ENERGY UPPORTUNITIES AMONG THE CONSUMING COUNTRIES, WHILE RECOGNIZING THAT ALL CONSUMING COUNTRIES WILL BENEFIT EQUALLY FROM THE MARKET IMPACT OF INCREASED PRODUCTION OF ENERGY BY ANY ONE OF THEM. AND IT SHOULD CREATE A BASIS ON WHICH STABLE ECONOMIC AND POLITICAL

RELATIONSHIPS CAN BE NEGOTIATED WITH THE PHODUCING COUN-TRIES.

AT MY REQUEST, SECRETARY KISSINGER HAS ADVANCED A SET OF PROPOSALS FOR CONSUMER COOPERATION ON ACCELERATED DEV-ELUPMENT. THESE PROPOSALS INCLUDE A COMMITMENT BY NEMBERS OF THE INTERNATIONAL ENERGY AGENCY TO PROVIDE PRO-TECTION AGAINST FUTURE PRICE UNCERTAINTY FOR INVESTORS IN CONVENTIONAL NUCLEAR AND FUSSIL FUELS IN OUR COUNTRIES, EITHER BY A CUMMON FLOOR PRICE OR TARIFF! AN AGREEMENT SETTING FORTH THE GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH MEMBER COUNTRIES COULD PARTICIPATE IN EACH OTHER'S PHOGRAMS TO DEVELOP SYNTHETIC FUELS AND OTHER HIGHER COST ENERGY SOURCES; AND A SIMILAR AGREEMENT UNDER WHICH TWO OR MORE MEMBER COUNTRIES COULD POOL THEIR ENERGY HESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT EFFORTS IN SPECIFIC AREAS AND PROJECTS.

WITHIN THIS FRAMEWORK, IT SHOULD BE POSSIBLE TO ASSURE AN EQUITABLE BALANCE OF COST AND BENEFITS AMONG PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES, COUNTRIES WITH LARGE FOSSIL FUEL POTENTIAL WOULD ACHIEVE GREATER SELF-SUFFICIENCY, BUT WOULD HAVE TO ASSUME THE LANGER SHARE OF THE INVEST-MENT BURDEN. COUNTRIES WHOSE PRINCIPAL DOMESTIC ENERGY OPPORTUNITY IS INCREASED NUCLEAR POWER WOULD OBTAIN THE DALANCE OF PAYMENTS AND FISCAL BENEFIT OF LOWER OIL PICES AS INVESTMENT IN OTHER PARTS OF THE IEA RESULTED IN LOHER WORLD PRICES. WE WOULD ALL AGREE NOT TO INCREASE OUR COMSUMPTION OF IMPORTED OIL IF PRICES FELL.

I UNDERSTAND THAT COUNTRIES SUCH AS JAPAN, WHICH HAVE RELATIVELY LITTLE DOMESTIC POTENTIAL TO DEVELOP FUSSIL FUELS, MIGHT BE CUNCERNED OVER THE NEED TO ASSURE THAT THEY WOULD HAVE ACCESS TO THE NEW ENERGY SUPPLIES PRODUCED IN OTHER IEA COUNTRIES UNDER SUCH A FRAMEWORK CONFIDENTIAL

THAT IN AN EFFORT TO STREGTHEN OUR DVERALL COOPERATIVE FRANEWORK, WE SHOULD EXAMINE THE MERITS OF POSSIBLE UNDERTAKINGS REGARDING ACCESS TO SUPPLY AND TO MARKETS FOR ENERGY PRODUCED WITHIN DUR COUNTRIES.

I AM OPTIMISTIC THAT WE WILL BE ABLE TO MAKE SUBSTANTIAL PROGRESS IN THIS AREA WITHIN THE NEXT FEW WEEKS AND THUS THAT WE WILL BE IN A PUSITION TO HOLD A PREPARATORY MEETING BY THE END OF MARCH FOR THE FURMAL DIALOGUE WITH THE DIL PRODUCING COUNTRIES. CLEARLY, WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO REACH DETAILED AGREEMENT ON ALL ASPECTS OF OUR COOPERATION IN ACCELERATED DEVELOPMENT BY THE END OF MARCH.

HOWEVER, I BELIEVE WE MUST REACH A FIRM UNDERSTANDING ON THE BASIC ELEMENTS AND PRINCIPLES OF OUR OVERALL APPROACH ON ACCELERATED DEVELOPMENT BEFORE BEGINNING DISCUSSIONS WITH THE PRODUCERS. WE CANNOT HOPE TO ACHIEVE AGREEMENT WITH PRODUCERS ON THE ELEMENTS OF A LONG-TERM EQUILIBRIUM OF INTERESTS BETWEEN US UNLESS WE AS CONSUMERS HAVE FIRMLY ESTABLISHED OUR OWN COMMON MEASURES OF COOPERATION IN THIS IMPORTANT AREA OF OUR OVERALL COOPERATIVE EFFORT.

I WOULD LIKE TO TAKE THIS OPPORTUNITY TO CONVEY TO YOU PERSONALLY MY APPRECIATION FOR THE POSITIVE CONTRIBUTION JAPAN IS MAKING TO THE WORK OF THE INTERNATIONAL ENERGY AGENCY AND YOUR VERY CONSTRUCTIVE ROLE IN OUR JOINT EFFORT TO RESOLVE THE ENERGY CHISIS. SINCERELY, GERALD R. FORD. END TEXT.

SUBJECT: JAPANESE ANDASSADOR'S MEETING WITH UNDERSECRETARY SISCO ON MIDEAST DEVELOPMENTS

1. JAPANESE AMBASSADUR YASUKAWA CALLEU ON UNDERSECRETARY SISCO ON JUNE 6 FUR GENERAL UPDATE ON MIDDLE EAST DE-VELUPMENTS. CONVERSATION CENTERED ON SALZBURG MEETINGS BETWEEN THE PRESIDENT AND SADAT AND THE PROPOSED ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE PALKAGE FOR EGYPT.

2. PREFACING HIS REMARKS WITH A WARNING AGAINST THE UNDUE FLUCTUATIONS OF THE U.S. PRESS BETWEEN UNDUE OPTIMISM OF PRESSIMISM. THE UNDEFSECRETARY NOTED THAT THE PRESIDENT AND SADAT HAD ESTABLISHED EXCELLENT PERSONAL HAPPONT AT SALXBURG. THE PRESIDENT MAD BEEN IMPRESSED BY DAUAF'S STATESMANLIKE CHARACTER AND GRASP OF CONFIDENTIAL

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DETERMINATION NOT TO PERMIT EITHER STAGNATION OR STALEMATE IN MIDEAST PLACE EFFORTS.

FROM SALZBURG WITH THE GENERAL IMPRESSION THAT "THE DOOR IS STILL UPEN FUR PRUGRESS". HE HAVE NOT MADE ANY DEFICISION AS TO WHETHER THE INTERIM AGREEMENT OR GENEVA

CONFERENCE ROUTE WILL PROVE MOST FEASIBLE THE US WILL HAVE A BETTER SENSE OF THIS FULLOWING THE VISIT OF PRIME MINISTER HASIN TO MASHINGTON. WHILE CAUTIONING THAT WE ARE UNABLE TO POINT TO SPECIFIC CHANGES IN THE ISRAELI OR EGYPTIAN POLITICAL CLIMATE, THE UNDERSECRETARY DESCRIBED THE PRESENT ATMOSPHERE AS CAUTIOUSLY HOPEFUL.

4. ASKED TO ASSESS THE POSSIBILITY OF A NEW INTERIM EGYPTIAN-ISRAELI AGREEMENT, THE UNDERSECRETARY NOTED THAT THIS IS A POSSIBILITY BUT THAT IF THERE WERE NO NEW COUNCIDENCE OF VIEWS, THE PARTIES WOULD PROBABLY MOVE TO GENEVA. HE NOTED THAT BOTH OPTIONS - STEP BY STEP AND GENEVA - REMAINED OPEN.

S. YASUKAWA THEN RAISED THE PROPOSED MULTILATERAL ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE PACKAGE TO EGYPT ON INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE FUNEIGN MINISTRY. THE JAPANESE EMBASSY IN CAIRU HAD REPORTED THAT IN A MEETING WITH AN UNIDENTIFIED "JAPANESE PULTICIAN," FOREIGN MINISTER FAHMI HAD STATED THAT THE US AND EGYPT HAD AGREED IN SALZBUNG ON THE SPECIFIC BREAKDOWN OF THIS PACKAGE. OUT OF TOTAL \$1.5 BILLIUN, THE US MEPONTEDLY HOULD CONTRIBUTE \$500 MILLION, SAUDI ARABIA \$250 MILLION, IRAN \$200 MILLION, WEST GERMANY \$200 MILLION, JAPAN \$200 MILLION, WITH THE REMAINDER COMING FROM HEST EUROPE AND OTHER OIL PRODUCING COUNTRIES.

G. THE UNUERSECRETARY STATED THAT DISCUSSIONS WERE IN FACT IN TERMS OF AN OVERALL \$1.5 AMOUNT. HOWEVER, THE US HAD NOT ENTERED INTO ANY AGREEMENT THAT \$200 MILLION WAS THE AMOUNT JAPAN WAS EXPECTED TO COMMIT. HE ARE IN NO POSITION TO COMMIT JAPAN, ALTHOUGH IT IS OBVIOUSLY OUR HOPE THAT JAPAN WILL COMMIT AS GENEROUS AN AMOUNT AS POSSIBLE SINCE THE EGYPTIAN NEED IS GREAT.





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7. THE UNDERSECRETARY EXPLAINED THAT THE PRIMARY PURPUSE. OF THE PROPOSED ASSISTANCE WAS TO HELP EGYPT THROUGH ITS PRESENT FOREIGN EXCHANGE DIFFICULTIES. THIS WOULD BE BUDGETARY SUPPURT RATHER THAN PROJECT AID. WHILE THE OVERALL TOTAL OF \$1.5 BILLION WAS ACCURATE, THE US WAS PLANNING TO CONTRIBUTE \$250 MILLION AND HOPED BOTH SAUDI ARABIA AND IRAN COULD CONTRIBUTE SIMILAR AMOUNTS. IN ADDITION TO JAPAN, HEST GERMANY AND KUHAIT HAD BEEN CONTACTED IN REGARDS THIS PROPUSAL. WEST GERMANY HAD ALSO BEEN ASSED TO APPROACH THE EC ON THIS MATTER. THE US EXPECTED THE WORLD HANK TO PLAY A MANAGERIAL RULE IN PROMOTING EGYPTIAN FISCAL EFFICIENCY, WHICH THE BANK WAS PREPARED TO OU ON INVITATION FROM THE EGYPTIANS.

8. YASUKAWA EXPLAINED THAT THE GOJ WAS STILL STUDYING THE PROPOSAL. THE UNDERSECRETARY EXPRESSED THE HOPE THAT THE GOJ MOULD DO THE BEST IT COULD." HE REGRETTED THAT THIS CONFUSION REGARDING THE PROPOSED ASSISTANCE PACKAGE HAD ARISEN AND URGED THE AMBASSAUDR TO CONTACT HIM SHOULD ANY NORE GUESTIONS ARISE.

9. COMMENT: SISCU DID NOT INDICATE ANY SPECIFIC FIGURE THAT HAS EXPECTED FROM JAPAN, SINCE IT IS CLEAR FROM EMBASSY CAIRD REPURIS THAT THE PROBLEM OF THE OVERALL AMOUNT AND PROSPECTIVE INDIVIDUAL COMMITMENTS NEED FURTHER CLARIFICATION WITH THE EGYPTIANS. THIS WILL BE REVIEWED FROM HERE PROMPTLY, WITH A VIEW TO DETERMINING HOW BEST TO CLARIFY SITUATION.

MINISTER: AS WE PREPARE TO SEND OUR DELEGATIONS TO THE NEXT MEETING OF THE GOVERNING GOARD OF THE INTERNATIONAL ENERGY AGENCY, I THINK IT ESSENTIAL THAT OUR TWO GOVERNMENTS HAVE THE FULLEST PUSSIBLE APPRECIATION OF OUR RESPECTIVE POSITIONS ON THE ISSUES TO BE CONSIDERED IN PARIS. THE WORK OF THE 1EA IN PREHARING FOR A RESUMPTION OF THE CONSUMERYPRODUCER DIALOGUE AND IN ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE PROGRAM OF LONG TERM COOPERATION IS OF GREAT IMPORTANCE TO MY GOVERNMENT. I KNOW YOU SHARE OUR CONCERN THAT THESE MATTERS GU FORWARD IN AN EFFICIENT AND EFFECTIVE MANNER.

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ACCURDINGLY, 1 AM PREPARED TO SENU ASSISTANT SECRETARY THUMAS U. ENDERS TO TONYO ON JUNE 25 TO MEET WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF THE FOREIGN MINISTRY AND OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES IN THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT FOR A BILATERAL EXCHANGE ON CONSUMER/PRODUCER RELATIONS AND LONG. TERM COUPERATION.

ON JUNE 30 THE GOVERNING BOARD MUST ACT ON A PROPOSED LONG TERM PRUGRAM IN ORDER TO KEEP FAITH WITH THE COMMITMENT HE MADE WHEN WE ADUPTED THE INTERNATIONAL EMERGY PROGRAM AND WHICH WE CONFIRMED IN THE COMMUNIQUE OF THE MAY 27 MINISTERIAL MEETING. AN EFFELTIVE LONG TERM PROGRAM WILL REGIN TO RESTORD BALANCE IN INTERNATIONAL ENERGY MARKETS AND IMPROVE OUR OVERALL PUSTURE VIS-A-VIS THE DIL EXPURTING COUNTRIES. THIS IS OF COURSE PARTICULARLY IMPORTANT AS WE LOOK TOWARD A RESUMPTION OF THE DIALOGUE WITH PRODUCERS IN THE RELATIVELY NEAR FUTURE.

I AM SURE YOU WILL AGREE THAT IT IS PARTICULARLY IMPORTANT THAT OUR TWO GOVERNMENTS CAREFULLY COURDINATE DUR POSITIONS ON A BILATERAL BASIS AS HE APPROACH THIS IMPURTANT PHASE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE IEA15 OWN COOPERATIVE PROGRAM AND OUR POLICY TOWARDS THE OIL PRODUCERS.
