I COMMUNICATED IMMEDIATELT WITH PRESIDENT ASAD.
INFORMING HIM OF THE ISRAELI STATEMENTS. MY PURPOSE
WAS TO ASSURE FULL UNDERSTANDING ON EACH SIDE OF THE
OTHER'S MOVES AND STATED PURPOSES. I HAD A VERY
PROMPT AND WARM RESPONSE FROM PRESIDENT ASAD TO THE
EFFECT THAT SYRIA DID NOT INTEND TO INITIATE MILITARY
ACTION, ESPECIALLY AT THIS, TIME WHEN THERE IS HOPE
OF NEW DIPLOMAITC PROGRESS.
WHEN I INFORMED THE ISRAELT GOVERNMENT OF

PRESIDENT ASAD'S MESSAGE THE ISRAELIS PEPEATED
THAT THEY HAD NO INTENTION OF INTITATING MILITARY
ACTION. THE ISRAELI AMBASSADOR SAID THIS PUBLICLY
AT THE STATE DEPARTMENT AFTER MEETING WITH ME. AND
SINCE THAT TIME THERE SEEMS TO HAVE BEEN SOME REDUCTION
OF TENSION. AT LEAST IN THE PUBLIC HANDLING OF THE

SITUATION .. AS YOUR MAJESTY KNOWS, HOWEVER, BOTH SIDES REMAIN IN A HIGHT STATE MILITARY READINESS, AND THE RESUMPTION OF HOSTILITIES BY MISCALUCLATION CANNOT AT ALL BE RULED OUT. REGRETTABLY. THE COMING PERIOD OF DEBATE OVER WHETHER THE MANDATE OF THE UNDOF SHOULD BE RENEWED WILL CONTRIBUTE TO KEEPING TENSION AT A LEVEL ABOVE THAT OF LAST WEEK THAT FOREING MINISTER KHADDAM HAD TOLD SECRETARY GENERAL WALDHEIM THAT SYRIA WOULD NOT AGREE TO EXTENSION OF THE UNDOF MANDATE, I WROTE TO PRESIDENT ASAD POINTING OUT THAT SYRIA'S REFUSAL TO AGREE TO UNDOF'S CONTINUED OPERATION WOULD BE READ IN ISRAEL AS AN ABROGATION OF THE DISENGAGEMENT AGREEMENT. IT HAS BEEN SUGGESTED THAT SYRIA WOULD AGREE TO THE PRESENCE OF 100 UN DESERVERS. THIS WAS PROPOSED AT THE BEGINNING OF THE DISENGAGEMENT NEGOTIATIONS LAST MAY AND WAS REJECTED BY ISRAEL.

NEGOTIATIONS PRODUCED AGREEMENT BY BOTH SIDES TO THE UNDOF IN ITS PRESENT STZE AND UNDER ITS PRESENT MANDATE. THE PROTOCOL RECORDING THAT AGREEMENT IS PART OF THE DISENGAGEMENT AGREEMENT. I WANT YOU TO KNOW THAT I HAVE INVITED FOREIGN MINISTER ALLON TO COME TO WOSHINGTON THE FIRST WEEK IN DECEMBER AS SOON AS I HAVE RETURNED FROM CHINA. A FAILURE TO RENEW THE UNDOF MANDATE WOULD GIVE THE ISRAELIS AN EXCUSE FOR NOT MOVING FURTHER IN THE NEGOTIATIONS AND WOULD HELP THOSE ELEMENTS OF AMERICAN PUBLIC OPINION WHO ARE INTENT ON DISREDITING THOSE OF US WHO ARE TRYING. TO ADVANCE THE CAUSE OF PEACE IN THE MIDDLE EAST. I WANTED TO ASSURE YOU MAJESTTY SACCURATE UNDER-STANDING OF THE STEPS WE HAVE TAKEN TO HELP MAINTAIN STABILITY SO THAT, IN YOUR OWN CONSULTATIONS WITH OTHER ARAB LEADERS, YOU WILL KNOW HOW WE SEE THE ISSUES BEFORE US AND WHAT WE ARE TRYING TO ACHEIVE.






