PLEASE PASS FOLLOWING ORAL MESSAGE TO BITSIOS FROM ME:

I. I HAVE REVIEWED THE SITUATION WITH RESPECT TO CYPRUS AND I HAVE CONCLUDED THAT I SHOULD NOT VISIT ANKARA AT THIS TIME, IT IS CLEAR, IN LIGHT OF MY EXCHANGES WITH TURKEY, THAT IN A 24 HOUR PERIOD IT MAY NOT BE POSSIBLE TO HAVE A SATISFACTORY DUTCOME. MOREDVER THE UNILATERAL GESTURES TURKEY IS PREPARED TO MAKE IN THE ABSENCE OF ANY RECIPROCITY DO NOT WARRANT THE ENORMOUS SPECIAL EXERTION AND THE WORLD WIDE ATTENTION FOCUSSED ON SUCH AN EFFORT. THEREFORE, I SUGGEST THAT WE GO BACK TO THE ORIGINAL PLAN AND ATTEMPY TO REACH AGREEMENT ON A SET OF PRINCIPLES AND OBTAIN AT THE SAHE TIME SIGNIFICANT GESTURES THAT WOULD HAVE A BENEFICIAL EFFECT ON THE ATMOSPHERE.

WHEN WE TALKED IN ROME, YOU DID NOT FEEL THAT THERE WAS ENOUGH TIME TO AGREE ON THE PRINCIPLES AND, OF COURSE, YOUR GOVERNMENT WAS PREOCCUPED WITH THE ELECTIONS, I



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WONDER IF YOU COULD NOT REEXAMINE THE EXCAMNGES WE HAVE HAD ON THE PRINCIPLES AND PARTICULARLY GIVE ME YOUR THOUGHTS ON THE LATEST SUGGESTIONS MADE BY THE TURKISH GOVERNMENT WHICH I GAVE YOU IN ROME, I DO NOT BELIEVE THAT THE POSITIONS ARE SO FAR APART THAT HE CANNOT FIND WORDS WHICH WOULD GUIDE THE NEGOTIATIONS, AND STILL NOT PREJUDGE THE OUTCOME OF THE NEGOTIATIONS, IN THIS WAY, WE CAN ALSO OBTAIN MUCH MORE SIGNIFICANT GESTURES FROM THE TURKS AND THE NEGOTIATIONS WILL THUS BEGIN IN AN ATMOSPHERE CONDUCTVE TO SUCCESS. WHEN I HAVE YOUR COM-MENTS AND AN AUTHORITATIVE STATEMENT FROM THE NEW TURKISH GOVERNMENT WE WILL SEE IF IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO REACH AGREEMENT QUICKLY. I PLAN TO BE IN BRUSSELS ALL DAY ON THE 11TH OF DECEMBER PRIOR TO THE NATO MEETING AND THIS TIME MIGHT OFFER US THE OPPORTUNITY FOR CON-CENTRATED DISCUSSIONS.

3. IN THE MEANTIME, I HOPE THAT YOU WILL FIND IT POSSIBLE TO CALM YOUR SUPPORTERS IN THE UNITED STATES. CONTINUED PRESSURE FROM THAT QUARTER WILL NOT, I ASSURE YOU, IMPROVE THE CHANCES OF OUR ACHIEVING PROGRESS. END TEXT.



AND REFLECTS ALSO THE AMERICAN COMMITMENT TO TAKE INTO ACCOUNT THE LEGITIMATE INTERESTS OF THE PALESTINIAN PEOPLE IN ANY JUST AND LASTING SOLUTION. DEAR MR. PRIME MINISTER!

I HAVE ABKED UNDER SECRETARY SISCO TO PASS TO AMBASSSAOR DINITZ AS SOON AS POSSIBLE THE FINAL TEXT OF THE MIDDLE EAST PORTION OF THE COMMUNIQUE FOLLOWING THE VLADIVOSTOR MEETINGS BETWEEN PRESIDENT FORD AND GENERAL SECRETARY BREZHNEV ALONG WITH THIS PERSONAL REPORT OF THOSE TALKS.

THE ESSENTIAL POINT IS THAT WE CONCEDED NOTHING AT ALL ON THE MIDDLE EAST AND THERE IS NO IMPEDIMENT TO OUR PROCEEDING AS HE HAVE DISCUSSED. YOU MAY PEST ASSURED THAT WE DID NOT DEVIATE IN ANY WAY FROM THE STRATEGY WHICH THE PRESIDENT AND I HAVE DISCUSSED WITH YOU AND YOUR COLLEAGUES.

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THE SOVIET LEADERS PRESSED VERY HARD ONCE AGAIN ON THE MIDDLE EAST, COMPLAINING OF OUR UNHILLINGNESS TO ACT IN CONCERT WITH THEM. THEY CLAIMED THAT THE CONTINUED STALEMATE IN THE MIDDLE EAST OTE IS POISONING THE ATMOSPHERE OF DETENTE. UNGTE. THE PRESIDENT HELD FIRMLY TO THE NECESSITY FOR THE CAREFUL. STEP-BY-STEP APPROACH TO A NEGOTIATED PEACE SETTLEMENT WHICH WE ARE PURSUING. BREZHNEY PARTICULARLY PRESSED FOR EARLY RESUMPTION OF THE GENEVA CONFERENCE, AND THE PRESIDENT HELD TO THE POSITION THAT ANY RESUMPTION WOULD HAVE TO BE WELL PRESPONDED AND APPROPRIATELY TIMEO.

ON THE COMMUNIQUE, YOU WILL SEE THAT THE TWO PARAGRAPHS ON THE MIDDLE EAST AREAK NO NEW GROUND AND REPRESENT NO NEW DECISIONS OR AGREEMENTS. THE LANGUAGE IS ESSENTIALLY THE SAME AS THE LAST COMMUNIQUE ISSUED IN CONNECTION WITH A PRESIDENTIAL VISIT TO THE SOVIET UNION. THE COMMUNIQUE REPEATS OUR COMMITMENT TO A GTE JUST AND LASTING PEACE, UNDTE AS YOUR GOVERNMENT DESIRED, WITH RESOLUTION 33H AS THE BASIS FOR EFFORTS TO PROMOTE A SOLUTION OF THE KEY ISSUES.

ON THE QUESTION OF THE PALESTINIANS, THE PHRASEOLOGY IS VIRTUALLY IDENTICAL TO THE LANGUAGE OF THE JULY 3, 1974, COMMUNIQUE. THE PRESIDENT ENSURED, HOWEVER, THE INCLUSION OF THE CRUCIAL OFFSETTING COMMITMENT TO GTE THE RIGHT TO INDEPENDENT EXISTENCE OF ALL STATES IN THE AREA, UNDTE AS YOUR GOVERNMENT DESIRED. WE INTEND TO MAKE CLEAR PUBLICLY OUR VIEW THAT THE REFERENCE TO THE PALESTINIANS HAS NO NEW SIGNIFICANCE AND REFLECTS NO ALTERATION OF AMERICAN POLICY.

IN SHORT, WHILE VLADIVOSTOK TALKS SIGNIFICANTLY ADVANCED THE US-SOVIET RELATIONSHIP ON OTHER MATTERS OF GLOBAL IMPORTANCE, NOTHING WAS DONE THAT IN ANY WAY AFFECTS OUR PURSUING TOGETHER THE COURSE OF ACTION WE HAVE DISCUSSED.
