I WISH TO BRING TO YOUR ATTENTION THAT CONTINUED DELAY IN MY KEEPING APPOINTMENT WITH ACTING FONMINISTER TO MAKE THE "FORMAL DENIAL" WHICH I WAS AUTHORIZED TO MAKE IN STATE 255877 IS ONLY SERVING TO MAKE A BAD SITUATION WORSE BY TENDING TO DISPLAY UNCERTAINTY TOWARD AND SEEMINGLY ADDING CONFIRMATION TO PRESIDENT VELASCO'S UNFOUNDED CHARGES. THIS IS PARTICULARLY DIFFICULT FOR ME SINCE THE ACTING FONMINISTER KNOWS THE SUBJECT MATTER OF MY CALL. ROUTINELY, WHEN A REQUEST

IS MADE TO SEE THE ACTING FONMINISTER, THE CHIEF OF PROTOCOL ASKS THE SUBJECT OF THE CALL AND IN THIS CASE WAS TOLD PRIVATELY AND ORALLY BY THE DCM WHEN HE REQUESTED THE APPOINTMENT ON NOVEMBER 21 THAT I WAS COMING IN WITH REFERENCE TO CHARGES MADE AGAINST FRANK ORTIZ AND ME IN PRESIDENT VELASCO'S PRESS CONFERENCE OF NOVEMBER 13. THE IMPLICATIONS OF CONTINUED DELAY, THEREFORE, ARE UNFORTUNATELY OBVIOUS.

2. I AM AWARE OF THE SECRETARY'S INTEREST IN THIS MATTER AND WILL OF COURSE ACT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE INSTRUCTIONS I HAVE RECEIVED IN THE MENTIONED TELEGRAM AS MODIFIED ORALLY IN CONVERSATIONS WITH OFFICE DIRECTOR ORTIZ AND IN ANY FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS I MAY RECEIVE, EVEN THOUGH I PERSONALLY BELIEVE THE OUTLINE OF REMARKS WHICH I PROVIDED IN MVD 3440 TO BE ENTIRELY APPROPRIATE; BUT I DO ASK THAT THE SECRETARY BE MADE AWARE OF THE INCREASING URGENCY OF THE MATTER SO THAT I CAN ACT AT THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE MOMENT. YOUR ARE, OF COURSE, AWARE THAT I WOULD HAVE ACTED MUCH EARLIER ON THIS BASIS OF TELEGRAPHIC INSTRUCTIONS RECEIVED BUT THAT I TELEPHONED AMBASSADOR BOWDLER TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE DEPARTMENT REALLY INTENDED TO AUTHORIZE A WRITTEN COMMUNICATION ABOUT WHICH WE HAD DOUBTS. STATE 255877 AUTHORIZED A "FORMAL DENIAL" AND IN MY EXPERIENCE IN THE FOREIGN SERVICE FORMAL HAS GENERALLY MEANT WRITTEN. IT NOW RESULTS THAT MY DESIRE TO CLEAR THIS AMBIGUITY AND TO BE SURE THAT I WAS ACTING IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE DEPARTMENT'S REAL WISHES IN A DELICATE MATTER HAS PRODUCED DELAYS WHICH ARE EVER MORE EMBARRASSING TO ME.

1. USLO SHOULD RESPOND ORALLY TO TING YUAN-HUNG WITH FOLLOWING STATEMENT, NOTING THAT YOU ARE ACTING UNDER DEPARTMENT'S INSTRUCTIONS. YOU SHOULD AVOID IF POSSIBLE FURTHER DISCUSSION AFTER MAKING THIS STATEMENT.
2. QUOTE THE U.S. GOVERNMENT DOES NOT AGREE THAT WILLIAM STOKES WAS INVOLVED IN ESPIONAGE DURING THE PERIOD HE WAS ASSIGNED TO CHINA. THE U.S. GOVERNMENT HAS FULL CONFIDENCE IN ANY OFFICIAL IT SENDS TO CHINA. UNQUOTE
3. FYI, TING'S STATEMENT THAT STOKES HAD BEEN EXPELLED FROM CHINA FOR "ESPIONAGE INVOLVEMENT" PRESUMABLY REFERS TO THE BLANKET EXPULSION ORDER COVERING THE MUKDEN CONGEN STAFF. THERE WAS NO SPECIFIC CHARGE AGAINST STOKES WHILE HE WAS IN MUKDEN. THERE WAS, HOWEVER, A MISUNDERSTANDING WHICH LED THE USG TO REQUEST VARIOUS GOVERNMENTS

TO PROTEST TO PRC ABOUT STOKES HAVING BEEN TAKEN AWAY IN
CONNECTION WITH AN ESPIONAGE TRIAL. ON NOVEMBER 25, 1949

THE CHINESE AUTHORITIES OFFERED STOKES AN OPPORTUNITY TO ATTEND AS AN OBSERVER THE TRIAL (NOT FOR ESPIONAGE) OF CONSUL GENERAL WARD AND FOUR OTHER CONGEN STAFF MEMBERS, WHICH HE DID. ON NOVEMBER 27, A SIMILAR OFFER WAS MADE REGARDING TRIAL OF SOME NON-AMERICANS ACCUSED OF HAVING BEEN ENGAGED IN ESPIONAGE FOR THE USG. AFTER CHECKING WITH WARD, BY THEN RELEASED, STOKES ACCEPTED OFFER. DURING THAT DAY, WHILE STOKES WAS ATTENDING TRIAL, WARD RECEIVED A CALL FROM PEKING CONSUL GENERAL CLUBB, WHO THEN REPORTED TO THE DEPARTMENT THAT STOKES HAD BEEN TAKEN AWAY IN CONNECTION WITH AN ESPIONAGE TRIAL. RESULTS WERE AS MENTIONED ABOVE, AS WELL AS WESTERN PRESS STORIES THAT STOKES HAD BEEN ACCUSED OF ESPIONAGE. ON NOVEMBER 28, THE ENTIRE AMERICAN STAFF OF MUKDEN CONGEN WAS ESCORTED TO TIENTSIN AND PUT ABOARD AN AMERICAN FREIGHTER.

4. POSSIBLY RELATED TO TING'S STATEMENT IS FACT THAT HONG KONG SOUTH CHINA MORNING POST NOVEMBER 27 THIS YEAR, IN COLUMN "25 YEARS AGO TODAY," RECALLED THAT STOKES HAD BEEN "RELEASED" BY THE CHINESE. KISSINGER

SUBJECT: INCURSION OF PRC AIRSPACE BY US AIRCRAFT

REF: STATE 22571

1. HABIB CALLED IN PRCLD DEPUTY CHIEF HAN HSU FEBRUARY 4 TO INFORM HIM OUR INVESTIGATION SHOWED THAT IT LIKELY US AIRCRAFT INADVERTENTLY PENETRATED PRC AIRSPACE ON MORNING OF JANUARY 28 AT POINT APPROXIMATELY 75 MILES NORTHEAST OF AMOY. HABIB EMPHASIZED THAT WE SINCERELY REGRETTED THIS INCIDENT AND ARE UNDERTAKING MEASURES TO PREVENT RECURRENCE.

2. HAN SAID HE WOULD REPORT THIS INFORMATION TO PEKING AND THANKED US FOR TAKING MEASURES TO AVOID FUTURE INCIDENTS.

3. WE ARE QUITE CERTAIN FROM HAN'S RELAXED REACTION THAT

1. WE RECOGNIZE YOUR INTEREST IN THIS MATTER. WE HAVE SENT YOU OTTAWA'S 1591 REPORTING THAT CANADIAN OFFICIAL PUBLICLY CONFIRMED THAT PRC PRESS ATTACHE HAD BEEN ASKED TO LEAVE. WE ARE SENDING BY SEPARATE MESSAGE AN FBI REPORT INDICATING POSSIBLE LINKAGE OF AN AMERICAN CITIZEN WITH THIS CASE.

2. AS FAR AS WE CAN DETERMINE, THERE IS NO GRAND JURY ACTION AT PRESENT. WE UNDERSTAND THAT U.S. CUSTOMS SERVICE

MAY WISH PROSECUTE THE AMERICAN CITIZEN FOR VIOLATION
CUSTOMS REGULATIONS, BUT THE PRC CONNECTION MAY NOT SURFACE
DURING THE TRIAL. WE ARE ASKING CUSTOMS TO KEEP US
INFORMED.

3. WASHINGTON CORRESPONDENT TORONTO GLOBE AND MAIL IS INVESTIGATING LEAD THAT CANADIAN GOVT. ACTION WAS BASED ON INFO PROVIDED BY USG, SO IT IS POSSIBLE STORY ALONG THOSE LINES MAY APPEAR.

4. BY ASKING FOR DEPARTURE OF PRC PRESS ATTACHE, CANADA WILL OBVIOUSLY TAKE BRUNT OF ANY PRC RETALIATION, AND ON BASIS PRESENT INFO WE DOUBT THAT MATTER WILL DEVELOP IN WAY WHICH WOULD LEAD TO PRC RETALIATION AGAINST USLO. WE WILL, OF COURSE, DO OUR BEST TO MINIMIZE ANY ADVERSE IMPACT ON US-PRC RELATIONS.

5. IN YOUR CONTACTS WITH CANADIANS PLEASE URGE THAT THEY STICK TO OTTAWA'S PUBLIC LINE AND DO NOTHING TO FEED SPECULATION. WE PARTICULARLY HOPE U.S. ANGLE WILL NOT BE PLAYED UP, BUT LEAVE TO YOU HOW BEST TO GET THIS POINT ACROSS. KISSINGER

1. WE HAVE SOME PROBLEMS WITH THE IDEA OF A VISIT TO PRC BY THE U.S. ADVISORY COMMISSION ON INFORMATION IN ITS OFFICIAL CAPACITY, PARTICULARLY IF, AS WE ASSUME, THE MEMBERS WOULD WANT TO TALK TO THE CHINESE ABOUT INFORMATION FLOW. IN FACT, IT IS VERY POSSIBLE PRC WOULD NOT AGREE TO THAT TYPE OF VISIT.
