(2) THE PROGRAM, IF INSTITUTED, WOULD (A) BEGIN WITH ASSEMBLY OF MIRAGE F-1 IN INDIA; (B) FOLLOW WITH INDIA ASSUMING RESPONSIBILITY FOR MANUFACTURING THE MORE SOPHISTICATED AIRCRAFT EQUIPMENT AND (C) RESULT IN THE CONSTRUCTION BY INDIA OF 250 AIRCRAFT UNDER LICENSE. THIS IS THE GOAL OF INDIA ACCORDING TO NOETINGER.
