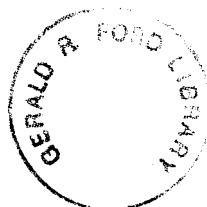

1. HUMMEL ASKED PRLO MR. CHI IF ANY PROBLEMS WOULD BE CAUSED IF SECRETARY WERE TO BRING MRS. KISSINGER AND HIS TWO CHILDREN ON PEKING TRIP. CHI SAID HE WOULD CHECK WITH PEKING.

2. HUMMEL ALSO TOLD CHI THAT SECRETARY WONDERED IF IT MIGHT BE POSSIBLE TO WORK IN A DAY OF SIGHTSEEING OUTSIDE PEKING AT THE END OF THE VISIT, AND THAT SECRETARY WAS THINKING OF PERHAPS VISITING SOOCHOW. CHI ASKED IF THIS MEANT AN EXTENSION OF THE DATES OF THE VISIT (25-29). 1. TODAY I PERSONALLY DELIVERED TO PREMIER CHIANG CHING-KUO TEXT OF ANNOUNCEMENT AND ACCOMPANYING MESSAGE AS INSTRUCTED REFTEL. PREMIER ACKNOWLEDGED THE INFORMATION AND THANKED ME FOR HAVING CONVEYED IT TO HIM. HE ADDED ONLY THAT HIS GOVERNMENT'S POSITION ON THESE MATTERS IS KNOWN FROM STATEMENTS AND COMMUNICATIONS MADE EARLIER, INCLUDING SOMETHING OF WHAT WAS CONTAINED IN HIS LETTER TO PRESIDENT FORD, PRESUMABLY LETTER TEXT OF WHICH CONTAINED STATE 228814. 1. WITH THE SECRETARY'S APPROVAL, WE SPLIT THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE ALTERNATIVE MESSAGES IN REFTEL AND TELEPHONED THE FOLLOWING TO GALLAGHER. QUOTE GEORGE BUSH HAS ASKED US TO LET YOU KNOW THAT HE DISCUSSED WIRE SERVICE REPRESENTATION IN PRC WITH CHU MU-CHIH, DIRECTOR OF NCNA. CHU WAS UNWILLING TO DISCUSS MATTER IN DEPTH, BUT HIS LIMITED COMMENTS GAVE THE IMPRESSION THAT THE PRC IS NOT PREPARED TO MOVE AHEAD ON THIS MATTER AT THE PRESENT TIME. NEVERTHELESS, BUSH HOPES THAT HIS MENTIONING THE MATTER WILL PROVE HELPFUL. HE ASKS THAT THIS REPORT OF HIS CONVERSATION WITH CHU SHOULD BE TREATED WITH GREAT CONFIDENCE. UNQUOTE

FYI WE HAVE BEEN TOUCH WITH PRCLD ON FOLLOWING SUBJECTS:

1. THE SECRETARY HAS SUGGESTED, AND THE CHINESE HAVE AGREED, THAT AN EXTRA DAY WILL BE DEVOTED TO SIGHTSEEING OUTSIDE OF PEKING ON NOVEMBER 29TH, AND THAT THE PARTY WILL LEAVE CHINA ON THE MORNING OF NOV. 30TH. SOOCHOW WAS MENTIONED BY THE SECRETARY AS A POSSIBILITY. THE CHINESE HAVE NOT YET SAID WHERE THE SIGHTSEEING WILL TAKE PLACE.
2. MRS. KISSINGER AND THE SECRETARY'S TWO CHILDREN WILL ACCOMPANY.
3. WE HAVE ASKED PRCLD WHETHER THE PRC INTENDS TO ISSUE ANY VISAS FOR US NEWSMEN TO COVER THE VISIT IN ADDITION TO ABOUT 12 NEWSMEN WHO WILL TRAVEL ON THE SECRETARY'S AIRCRAFT. WE HAVE ALSO ASKED ABOUT HOW MANY MIGHT BE GIVEN SEPARATE VISAS FOR THIS PURPOSE, IF THE PRC SO INTENDS. WE HAVE NO REPLY AS YET.
