FOR AMBASSADOR FROM SISCO

1. FYI. FOLLOWING RECEIPT OF REFTEL, I PHONED AMBASSADOR DINITZ TO FOLLOW UP ON FAHMY'S REQUEST THAT WE URGENTLY CONTACT THE ISRAELIS AND I TOLD DINITZ (A) THAT ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE EGYPTIANS FOR AN ISRAELI CARGO TO TRANSIT THE CANAL ON OCTOBER 22 BUT (B) THAT EGYPTIANS HAVE EXPLAINED THE PROBLEM POSED FOR THEM BY SOUTH AFRICAN ORIGIN OF THE CEMENT. I TOLD DINITZ THAT EGYPTIANS HAVE RAISED QUESTION OF WHETHER IT WOULD NOT BE POSSIBLE TO SUBSTITUTE SOME OTHER CARGO EVEN IF THIS WOULD MEAN A DELAY OF TWO OR THREE DAYS. I ELABORATED ON THE PARTICULAR PROBLEM POSED FOR EGYPT IN THE OAU CONTEXT. I ASKED DINITZ TO REPORT THIS URGENTLY TO HIS GOVERNMENT AND TO SEE WHETHER OR NOT SOME REASONABLE SOLUTION COULD BE FOUND. END FYI.

2. YOU MAY TELL FAHMY THAT I HAVE CALLED AMBASSADOR DINITZ, EXPLAINED THE PROBLEM, AND ASKED HIM URGENTLY TO SEE WHETHER A REASONABLE SOLUTION COULD NOT BE FOUND TO THIS PROBLEM. THE AMBASSADOR SHOWED APPRECIATION FOR THE PROBLEM RAISED

BY THE SOUTH AFRICAN ORIGIN OF THE CARGO AND SAID THAT HE WOULD WIRE HIS GOVERNMENT IMMEDIATELY FOR A RESPONSE.

US DEL SECRETARY FOR WOODS

1. THE PRESIDENT ANNOUNCED ON OCTOBER 20 SIGNATURE OF AN AGREEMENT ON PURCHASES BY THE USSR OF US GRAIN. AMB, HINTON BRIEFED AMB. YASUKAWA BEFORE THE ANNOUNCEMENT. YASUKAWA SAID THAT THE GOJ APPRECIATED MEASURES TAKEN BY THE US TO STABILIZE SUPPLY OF AND DEMAND FOR GRAIN, BUT INQUIRED WHETHER THE USG WOULD PLACE A HIGHER PRIORITY ON ITS LEGAL COMMITMENT TO THE USSR OR ITS TRADITIONAL SUPPLY RELATIONSHIP WITH JAPAN. AMB. HINTON POINTED OUT THAT UNDER THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT, IF THE US CROP WAS ABOVE 225 MILLION TONS, THERE WOULD BE PLENTY OF GRAIN TO GO AROUND. IF IT FELL BELOW THE 225 MILLION MARK THE US COULD REDUCE TO ZERO SHIPMENTS TO THE USSR. HE STATED THAT BECAUSE JAPAN IS OUR BEST REGULAR CUSTOMER FOR GRAIN, A HANDSHAKE WITH SECRETARY BUTZ RATHER THAN A LEGAL AGREEMENT IS SUFFICIENT TO ASSURE JAPANESE ACCESS TO THE US MARKET. YASUKAWA OBSERVED THAT IN THIS INSTANCE A POLITICAL UNDERSTANDING MAY BE BETTER THAN A LEGAL COMMITMENT.

1. SUMMARY: PRG ANNOUNCES RELEASE OF AMERICANS AND OTHER FOREIGNERS TO TAKE PLACE IN LATE OCTOBER OR EARLY NOVEMBER WITH ASSISTANCE OF UNHCR. END SUMMARY.

2. HANOI 20 OCTOBER ANNOUNCED THAT PRG "AGREES TO ALLOW FOREIGNERS WHO COULD NOT LEAVE SVN IN VIEW OF HOSTILITIES TO REPATRIATE NOW ACCORDING TO THEIR WISH." STATEMENT (IN ENGLISH) REFERRED SPECIFICALLY TO "A NUMBER OF US AND OTHER FOREIGNERS, MOSTLY MISSIONARIES," AND SAID UNHCR HAS AGREED TO ASSIST IN REPATRIATION, WHICH "MAY BE CARRIED OUT IN LATE OCTOBER OR EARLY NOVEMBER." (FULL TEXT BELOW).

3. UNHCR SADRUDDIN AGA KHAN (IN NY FOR UNGA) TELEPHONEDD/HA WILSON TO CONFIRM SAME INFORMATION, WHICH UNHCR RECEIVED BY LETTER FROM PRG OFFICE IN GENEVA. UNHCR IS ALSO ISSUING PRESS RELEASE IN NY, TEXT BELOW.

4. HANOI STATEMENT'S REFERENCE TO "MISSIONARIES" INDICATES THAT IT COVERS THE CHRISTIAN AND MISSIONARY ALLIANCE

MISSIONARIES AND OTHER AMERICANS (AMONG THEM A USAID OFFICIAL) CAPTURED MARCH 10 AT BAN ME THUOT. WE UNDERSTAND UNHCR IN GENEVA HAS RECEIVED A LIST OF NAMES OF THOSE TO BE RELEASED, WHICH WE EXPECT TO HAVE BY TOMORROW. WORDING OF STATEMENT MAY ALSO COVER THE FIFTY OR SO OTHER AMERICANS REMAINING IN SOUTH VIETNAM, WHO HAVE BEEN DENIED EXIT. UNHCR TOLD US IN CONFIDENCE THAT THE PRISONER GROUP IS ALREADY IN HANOI AND THAT REPATRIATION IS EXPECTED TO TAKE PLACE VIA VIENTIANE.

5. FOLLOWING IS PRESS GUIDANCE PREPARED FOR STATE DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN TO USE OCTOBER 21: BEGIN TEXT. WE HAVE SEEN THE REPORT BROADCAST FROM HANOI AND CONFIRMED BY THE UNHCR. WE WELCOME THIS ANNOUNCEMENT AND LOOK FORWARD TO THE EARLY REPATRIATION OF ALL AMERICANS WHO WISH TO LEAVE VIETNAM. END TEXT. IF ASKED IF THIS IS LINKED TO REPATRIATION OF VIETNAMESE FROM GUAM, WE PLAN TO SAY WE HAVE NO BASIS FOR ANY SPECULATION ON THAT.

6. WE ARE INFORMING FAMILIES AND CONCERNED MEMBERS OF CONGRESS, INCLUDING HOUSE SELECT COMMITTEE ON MISSING PERSONS OF PRG AND UNHCR ANNOUNCEMENTS.

7. FOLLOWING IS UNHCR ANNOUNCEMENT: BEGIN TEXT. UNITED NATIONS, N.Y., OCT. 20 - THE UNHCR, SADRUDDIN AGA KHAN, HAS TODAY RECEIVED THROUGH THE LIAISON IN GENEVA OF THE PRGRSVN THE FOLLOWING COMMUNICATION FROM THE VIETNAMESE AUTHORITY ON THE SUBJECT OF REPATRIATION OF A CERTAIN NUMBER OF FOREIGNERS AT PRESENT IN VIETNAM:

-- ,BEFORE 30 APRIL 1975, THE DAY OF THE TOTAL LIBERATION OF SVN, A CERTAIN NUMBER OF AMERICANS AND OTHER FOREIGNERS, MOSTLY MISSIONARIES, WERE NOT ABLE TO LEAVE SVN ON ACCOUNT OF THE MILITARY SITUATION. THE PRG IS NOW RESPONDING TO THEIR ASPIRATIONS TO RETURN TO THEIR COUNTRIES OF ORIGIN. THE UNHCR HAS ACCEPTED TO CARRY OUT THEIR REPATRIATION. THE OPERATION COULD TAKE PLACE AT THE END OF OCTOBER OR AT THE BEGINNING OF NOVEMBER 1975."

-- THE HIGH COMMISSIONER AND THE VIETNAMESE AUTHORITIES HAVE BEEN IN TOUCH ON THIS SUBJECT FOR SOME TIME. IN THE CONTEXT OF HIS GOOD OFFICES FUNCTION THE HIGH COMMISSIONER HAS ACCEPTED TO CARRY OUT THIS HUMANITARIAN ACTION. THE TRANSPORT OF THIS GROUP WILL TAKE PLACE FROM HANOI.

-- IT IS RECALLED THAT THE HIGH COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE HAS



ALREADY ASSISTED IN THE PAST THROUGH ITS AIRLIFT, FROM SAIGON TO VIENTIANE, IN THE REPATRIATION OF SEVERAL HUNDRED FOREIGNERS FROM SVN TO THEIR COUNTRIES OF ORIGIN. END TEXT.

8. FOLLOWING IS HANOI ANNOUNCEMENT: BEGIN TEXT. PRG AGREES TO ALLOW REPATRIATION OF FOREIGNERS (HANOI VNA IN ENGLISH 1610 GMT 20 OCT 75) -- THE PROVISIONAL REVOLUTIONARY GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH VIETNAM AGREES TO ALLOW FOREIGNERS WHO COULD NOT LEAVE SOUTH VIETNAM IN VIEW OF HOSTILITIES TO REPATRIATE NOW ACCORDING TO THEIR WISH, ACCORDING TO LIBERATION PRESS AGENCY (LPA).

-- IN A REPORT TODAY, THE AGENCY MADE KNOWN THAT A NUMBER OF U.S. AND OTHER FOREIGNERS, MOSTLY MISSIONARIES, COULD NOT LEAVE SOUTH VIETNAM IN VIEW OF HOSTILITIES PRIOR TO APRIL 30, 1975, THE DAY OF TOTAL LIBERATION OF SOUTH VIETNAM. NOW THE PRGRSVN AGREES TO ALLOW THE SAID PERSONS TO REPATRIATE ACCORDING TO THEIR WISH. THE OFFICE OF THE U.N. HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR REFUGEES HAS ACCEPTED TO ASSIST IN THEIR REPATRIATION, LPA SAID. THIS MAY BE CARRIED OUT IN LATE OCTOBER OR EARLY NOVEMBER THIS YEAR, THE AGENCY ADDED. END TEXT.

FM CHIAO WARNED OF A NEW WORLD WAR AND CALLED FOR A "TIT FOR TAT STRUGGLE" AGAINST AGGRESSORS. HIS CRITICISM OF DETENTE IS READ AS MAINLY DIRECTED AGAINST THE SOVIET UNION. "U.S. OFFICIALS PUT A POSITIVE INTERPRETATION ON CHIAO STATEMENT THAT SINO-U.S. RELATIONS SHOULD CONTINUE TO MOVE AHEAD."

"KISSINGER REPLIED THAT THE U.S. WILL RESIST WHEN ONE NATION TRIES TO IMPOSE ITSELF ON ANOTHER, BUT WILL REFRAIN FROM SEEKING CONFRONTATIONS."

MACLEAN WROTE, "U.S. OFFICIALS TOOK AN UPBEAT APPROACH. THEY SAID INITIAL PRIVATE TALKS BETWEEN THE U.S. AND THE CHINESE HAD BEEN RELAXED AND WARM, AND THEY INTERPRETED CHIAO'S REMARKS ABOUT CONTINUED PROGRESS



BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES AS GETTING KISSINGER'S FIVE-DAY VISIT OFF TO A GOOD START. CHINA'S CRITICISM OF DETENTE IS AN OFT-TOLD TALE, THEY ASSERTED, AND MAINLY DIRECTED AGAINST THE SOVIET UNION. CHIAO, SAID ELEGANT, "SHARPLY ATTACKED CONCEPT OF DETENTE", A "CORNERSTONE OF U.S. FOREIGN POLICY", BUT NOTED "WITH ONLY THE SLIGHTEST QUALIFICATION" THAT SINO-U.S. RELATIONS HAVE MOVED AHEAD IN RECENT YEARS AND AFFIRMED HIS CONFIDENCE IN ACTUAL PRACTICE OF SHANGHAI COMMUNIQUE. "... FOREIGN DIPLOMATS IN PEKING SAID THAT BUSH, BY INVITING THE RUSSIANS TO THE RECEPTION HONORING KISSINGER, APPEARED TO SHOW THAT THE UNITED STATES CAN PLAY THE SUBTLE DIPLOMATIC GAME THE CHINESE PRIZE."

GROWALD ADDED THAT "THE PEOPLE'S DAILY, THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER OF THE CHINESE COMMUNIST PARTY, PUBLISHED A PHOTOGRAPH OF MAD AND HIS VISITOR ON ITS FRONT PAGE. AT THE BOTTOM OF THE PAGE, A PICTURE THREE TIMES SMALLER SHOWED KISSINGER AND HIS WIFE, NANCY BEING GREETED BY TENG AND CHIAO."

3. TELEVISION

A. ABC EVENING NEWS:

REASNER: SECRETARY OF STATE KISSINGER MET WITH CHINESE LEADERS TODAY IN THE FIRST WORKING SESSION OF HIS VISIT TO PEKING. THE TALKS WERE CALLED CORDIAL AND FRANK. IN DIPLOMATIC LANGUAGE THAT OFTEN MEANS NOBODY GOT ANGRY ENOUGH TO WALK OUT OF THE MEETING.



KOPPEL: PROMPTNESS IS NOT NORMALLY ONE OF SECRETARY OF STATE KISSINGER'S OUTSTANDING VIRTUES, BUT THIS MORNING AT 08:00 O'CLOCK SHARP HE ARRIVED ON SCHEDULE AT THE GREAT HALL OF THE PEOPLE TO BEGIN HIS TALKS WITH CHINESE LEADERS. FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS: SET THE PROPER TONE FOR THE MEDIA.

KISSINGER BEGAN IN A BANTERING VEIN, REFERRING BACK TO HIS ILL-FATED EFFORT LAST NIGHT TO DELIVER PART OF HIS TOAST IN CHINESE. "THE FOREIGN MINISTER," SAID KISSINGER, "TOLD ME THAT THE NEXT TIME I SHOULD TALK IN GERMAN. THEN HE COULD UNDERSTAND ME."

TENG HSIAO-PING, WHO IS EITHER RUNNING THINGS OR SERVING AS THE FRONT MAN IN CHINA THESE DAYS, WASN'T ABOUT TO RISK WASTING SUBTLETIES ON A GROUP OF AMERICAN NEWSMEN. NOTING THAT IT HAS BEEN ALMOST A YEAR SINCE KISSINGER'S LAST VISIT HERE, TENG SAID THERE HAVE BEEN QUITE A FEW CHANGES IN THE WORLD SINCE THEN. THERE IS THE NEED TO EXCHANGE VIEWS, HE SAID. IT DOESN'T MATTER EVEN IF WE QUARREL A LITTLE.

THERE HAVE INDEED BEEN CHANGES, AND THE CHINESE ARE QUITE OPENLY WORRIED THAT THE SOVIET UNION HAS BEEN THE MAIN BENEFICIARY. MOSCOW HAS MADE INROADS TO INDOCHINA, HAS SOLIDIFIED ITS POSITION IN EASTERN EUROPE, AND -- WORST OF ALL FROM THE CHINESE POINT OF VIEW -- IS NEUTRALIZING THE UNITED STATES WITH SUGAR-COATED VISIONS OF DETENTE. AMERICAN EXPERTS ARE ALSO CONVINCED THAT THE CHINESE ARE TOTALLY BAPPLD BY THE MANNER IN WHICH THE U.S. CONGRESS IS RIPPING APART AMERICA'S OWN INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY. THE CHINESE ARE NOT, OF COURSE, CONCERNED FOR AMERICA'S SAKE BUT FOR THEIR OWN. IF THE UNITED STATES IS WEAKENED, EITHER THRU ITS OWN INTERNAL ACTIONS OR THOSE OF THE SOVIET UNION, IT LOOSES ITS VALUE AS A COUNTER BALANCE TO THE SOVIET THREAT AGAINST CHINA.

B. NBC NIGHTLY NEWS:

CHANCELLOR: SECRETARY OF STATE KISSINGER MET TODAY WITH MEMBERS OF THE CHINESE GOVERNMENT. LATER HE ATTENDED A CHINESE OPERA ABOUT THE COUNTRY'S REVOLUTIONARY STRUGGLE; KISSINGER DOZED OFF AT THAT PERFORMANCE MORE THAN ONCE. BUT LAST NIGHT HE ATTENDED A BANQUET GIVEN BY HIS HOSTS AND, AS DON OLIVER REPORTS, WAS QUITE WIDE AWAKE:

OLIVER: AT THE FIRST NIGHT'S BANQUET, THE CHINESE MADE IT QUITE CLEAR THEY ARE DISSATISFIED WITH THE PROGRESS



MADE IN U.S.-SINO RELATIONSHIPS AND DISTURBED BY THE DETENTE BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND THE SOVIET UNION. FOREIGN MINISTER CHIAO KUAN-HUA CHARGED THAT DETENTE HAS NOT DEVELOPED TO A NEW STAGE, THAT IN FACT THE DANGER OF A NEW WORLD WAR IS MOUNTING.

AFTER THE TOAST IT WAS KISSINGER'S TURN. (FILM CLIP OF SECRETARY) HE SAID THE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND CHINA ARE APPARENT, BUT THAT IN THE RELATIONSHIPS THAT AMERICA HAS WITH ONE COUNTRY THERE IS NO INTENT TO THREATEN THE SECURITY OF ANY OTHER COUNTRY.

THE FIRST NEGOTIATING SESSION WAS HELD IN THE MORNING OF THE SECOND DAY -- DR. KISSINGER MEETING VICE PREMIER TENG HSIAO-PING IN THE GREAT HALL OF THE PEOPLE. AS THEY POSED FOR PICTURES, TENG SAID IT'S ALWAYS GOOD TO EXCHANGE VIEWS; IT DOESN'T MATTER EVEN IF WE QUARREL. KISSINGER AGREED, ADDING, "IT GIVES THE PRESS SOMETHING TO WRITE ABOUT."

WHILE THE MEETINGS WERE GOING ON, NANCY KISSINGER WAS SHOPPING AT THE PEKING FRIENDSHIP STORE, LOOKING AT ANTIQUES AND CHINESE PRODUCTS ON SALE FOR THE BENEFIT OF FOREIGN TRAVELLERS. SHE BOUGHT A SHAVING BRUSH, WHICH SHE SAID WAS FOR HER HUSBAND.

THE FIRST COUPLE OF MEETINGS BETWEEN SECRETARY KISSINGER AND THE CHINESE VICE PREMIER WERE SAID TO BE CRUCIAL IN PRODUCING AN ATMOSPHERE OF SOME TRUST. THE NEXT STEP WILL BE TO MAKE THE CONCRETE PLANS FOR PRESIDENT FORD'S VISIT HERE NEXT MONTH. U.S. OFFICIALS SAID THAT THINGS WERE GOING WELL, BUT SOME OBSERVERS SAID THE CHINESE SEEMED TO BE MORE RESERVED THAN USUAL AND WORRIED ABOUT U.S. INTENTIONS.

C. CBS EVENING NEWS:

CRONKITE: SECRETARY OF STATE KISSINGER HAS BEGUN FORMAL MEETINGS WITH CHINESE LEADERS IN PEKING. THE AILING 77-YEAR OLD PREMIER CHOU EN-LAI STILL IS HOSPITALIZED, SO KISSINGER MET INSTEAD WITH 71-YEAR OLD DEPUTY PREMIER TENG HSIAO-PING. TENG NOTED THAT IT'S BEEN ALMOST A YEAR SINCE KISSINGER LAST VISITED CHINA, ADDING THAT THERE HAVE BEEN SEVERAL CHANGES IN THE WORLD SINCE THEN, IMPLYING BUT NOT MENTIONING THE U.S. SET-BACK IN SOUTH VIETNAM. THEIR AGENDA WILL INCLUDE THE SINO-AMERICAN DISPUTE OVER TAIWAN, TENSIONS ON THE KOREAN PENINSULA, AND ARRANGING PRESIDENT FORD'S EXPECTED LATE NOVEMBER VISIT. AN AMERICAN SPOKESMAN DESCRIBED THE FIRST DAY OF TALKS AS
