Jim Oates presented the Vice President a copy of the report to the President on the Jobs for Veterans Committee. The Vice President indicated he would try to present the President his copy at a meeting they were having later in the afternoon.

Oates advised that they were in the process of winding up the Committee as major tasks had been accomplished, and that the agencies of the government were accepting generally the recommendations of the Committee. The report would show that the Committee's efforts on obtaining jobs for veterans had been helpful and defused this as a sensitive national issue.

The Vice President praised Oates and the Committee for their services to the country in this particular effort.

Meeting closed with a general discussion of Calvin College.
