## MEMORANDUM OF CONVERSATION

<u>Kissinger:</u> Humphrey can fix the Karamanlis ceilings. They want to say there are no amendments and thus we would accept a Chile cutoff. I think we will get Eagleton anyway.

<u>President:</u> Why don't I call Scott, Griffin and Mansfield? If they won't fight Eagleton, there is no hope.

Why not go with a CRA?

<u>Kissinger:</u> If there is another Turkish amendment, I think we should withdraw from the Cyprus negotiation.

President: I agree.

[President calls Mahon.]

Kissinger: If they would extend the Continuing Resolution until March.
