29 radio actualities were prepared and fed to stations in Missouri, Iowa, New Jersey, California and Ohio. Individuals fed through the system included the President, Mrs. Ford, Rogers Morton, Senators Griffin, Baker and Percy, Ohio Governor James Rhodes, Missouri Governor Bond and Missouri State Attorney General John Danforth. 558 actual feeds were made.

TREASURER'S REPORT

A total of \$237,996.92 was received in contributions this past week, bringing to \$12,038,384.30 the amount of money received to date. There is currently a balance of \$204,906.56 on hand. A full Treasurer's Report is attached at TAB B.

FINANCE

As of June 7, seventeen states had surpassed their established fund-raising goals. 91.0% of the national goal has been attained.
