Don, you were right! Bud McFarlane just told Red, Terry and I that the Secretary of State has laid on the Economic Summit to commence on Saturday, November 15. You may recall that the President approved two fundraisers on Friday, November 14, in Raleigh, North Carolina, and Atlanta, Georgia. A luncheon is scheduled in Raleigh and the Atlanta event tentatively begins at 6:30 p.m. that day. These were approved last week and confirmation has been issued to the sponsoring groups.

Needless to say, these events are not compatible. It may still be early enough to change the fundraisers; but we must know immediately if we are to make an attempt to do this. Another alternative that could conceivably be done is a back breaker: namely to depart for Paris the evening of the 14th from Atlanta. Henry would probably object and I am sure the military would find it exceedingly difficult to accomplish. Needless to say it would be excruciating to the President.

I am sorry to lay this problem on you. However, if you can think of any good ways to better coordinate with the Secretary of State I am open for suggestions. Any guidance you can offer would be most helpful.

Leave fundraisers on, the President will discuss with Henry the need to change the Economic Summit date.

Attempt to change the date of the fundraisers.  
(Remember Mattingly and Broyhill are already goosey.)

Plan to depart for Europe from Atlanta.

Cancel fundraisers.

Cancel Economic Summit Conference.  
(Preferred recommendation.)
