BEALL

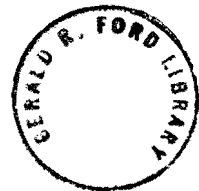
Ticket is a real plus. Doesn't see how anyone can complain.

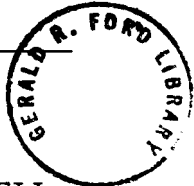
