My office has been receiving a considerable volume of outrageous mail and telephone calls in connection with the Vice President's solicitation letter on behalf of the National Republican Congressional Committee. The flak is being precipitated not by the letter, but by the solicitation slip enclosed with it which instructs addressees to make checks payable to "VICE PRESIDENT'S SPECIAL FUND". An example is attached.

I suspect most of the adverse reaction is on the part of those people who are against us anyway. In any case there is not much we can do about it now; any effort to correct the situation might just make it worse.

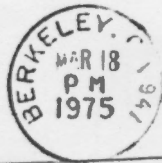

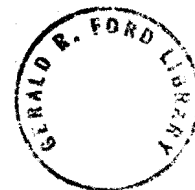
