2. Mr. Bennett missed a recent meeting the President held on this subject because of a House vote he did not wish to miss.

1. Although the President is awaiting the product of a DOD, NSC and OMB study, Mr. Bennett is very anxious to see or talk to him because the new Congressional Budget Committee process is involved. He also fears that the additional \$2 billion will be lost in a House-Senate conference unless the President makes a strong recommendation.
