BACKGROUND: Reverend David Hanks, the minister of Oak Forest United Methodist Church in Little Rock, is bringing 92 youth and their sponsors to Washington for a two-day visit here November 25, 26. They are Methodist Youth from Little Rock Annual Conference of the Methodist Church and are high school students, grades 9 through 12.

On Monday, the day you greet them, they will have toured the Bureau of Engraving and Printing, the monuments and memorials, the Washington Cathedral, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and the Iwo Jima Memorial.

The group will leave Washington Tuesday afternoon and continue on to New York City through Sunday, December 1st before returning to Little Rock.
