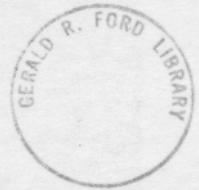

Clark MacGregor phoned today regarding Sunday Supper at their home at 2834 Foxhall Road at 6:30 PM on April 27, 1975.

Mr. MacGregor said that while they have invited some friends who are from the "press," any inquiries to the MacGregors from the media will be answered to the effect that it is a private party with no press or photo coverage. He feels that is the way you would want it and will stick to that if it is agreeable with you.
