# BACKGROUND

This prayer brunch will be the fourth professional athlete prayer event in which you have participated during the last five years. Attending will be approximately 90 athletes and coaches with spouses from the professional sports of baseball, football, basketball, tennis, golf, soccer and skating. Also attending are selected individuals who have been associated with the religious movement within pro sports.

Reverend Billy Zeoli has been largely responsible for the growth of Prayer Chapels within the pro sports environment. Previous prayer events were hosted by Reverend Zeoli. You expressed that an event hosted at the White House would be particularly appropriate in this Bicentennial year. The opportunity for young people to strengthen their own religious beliefs by realizing the religious convictions of many athletes is very great. Articles on this event and the religious convictions of those in attendance will be published in major sporting and general news publications as representives of <u>Sports Illustrated</u>, <u>Sports</u>, the <u>Sporting News</u>, the Los Angeles Times, and the <u>New York Times</u> are guests.
