Thank you for your attention and consideration toward this invitation.

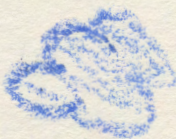
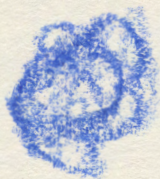

Archie is a Senior at Ohio State and may be the most famous Ohioan across the State. Woody Hayes is coach at Ohio State, which was number one in the big ten college football teams. Archie's mother and father have gotten a great deal of publicity across the State and everyone knows them. They have received a lot of favorable publicity because they are the epitome of the puritan work ethic. There are 8 children in this black family. Three older boys have already put themselves through college, and there are now three boys in college, Archie and two brothers. The two brothers still in college are also famous football players. Archie also has a younger brother in high school and a younger sister. The father has always worked two jobs, 20 hours a day, leaving the mother with the burden of raising the children. Mr. Griffin is a blue collar worker at Buckeye Steel and Columbus Division of Sanitation.

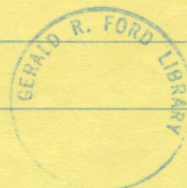

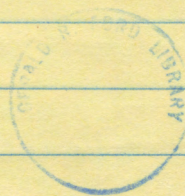

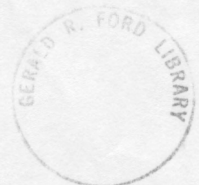
Thank you so much for taking time out from your very busy schedule to welcome me to Ohio. I had really been looking forward to another visit after my trip to Cleveland last year.



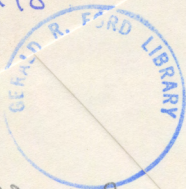

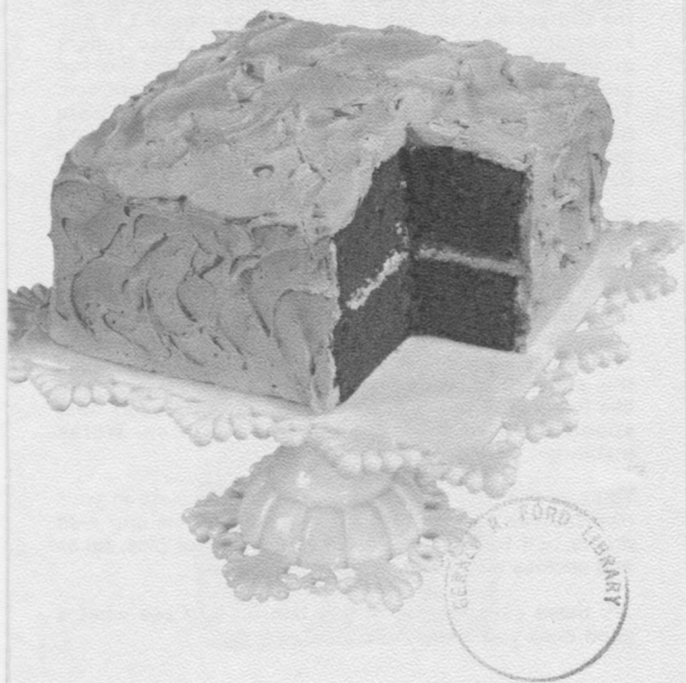

CHOCOLATE SPICE CAKE

...Favorite loaf cake with spicy chocolate flavor.

- 1 cup Ghirardelli Ground Chocolate
- 1½ cups flour
- 1 cup sugar
- 1½ tsp. pumpkin pie spice
- 1½ tsp. baking powder
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ½ cup butter or margarine, softened
- ¾ cup milk
- 1½ tsp. vanilla
- 2 eggs

Into mixer bowl, sift together Ground Chocolate, flour, sugar, spice, baking powder, salt. Make a well in center; add butter, milk, vanilla. Mix to blend, then beat 5 minutes on high speed of mixer. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Pour into greased 9 x 5-inch loaf pan. Bake at 325 degrees for about 1¼ hours. Cool; remove from pan. Serve plain or frosted. Decorate with walnuts, if desired.

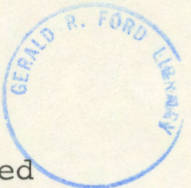
