

BEVERLY SILLS



NATIONAL ANTHEMS:

It is not necessary to play the Anthems at strictly social functions or at formal luncheons and dinners, as awkward situations and inconviences may result. When the Anthems are played, it is customary to play the Visitor's anthem first and then the Anthem of the United States second.

Facts: The Arts Council of Great Britain is 30 years old.
The National Council on the Arts (U.S.) is 10.
Ours is in great measure modeled on G.B.'s.

Beverly Sills is a member of U.S. Council.

Also, Van Cliburn, who will be a guest. (There are a total of 26 members, Presidential appointments.)

The President has strongly backed the Council, which is advisory, and the National Endowment for the Arts, which is the grant-making agency.

Mrs. Ford has expressed her interest in directing her energies to the arts.

Beverly Sills is an active member of the National Council; she also has been very active in New York in obtaining greatly increased monies (\$34. million this year)

Rough Thoughts for President We thought it particularly appropriate to honor you, Mr. Prime Minister, by having Beverly Sills with us this evening. Of course, as every one knows, her voice brings joy to all who hear her. What many many not know is how instrumental she has been in working toward public support of the arts in this country. In this endeavor, we are following the leadership of your great country in recognizing that our cultural life is a matter of government concern as well as private. Your Arts Council is 30 years old; ours only 10 and in many ways is modeled after your experience. (Your Council was established in the darkest days of World War II, which speaks to the value of the arts and your country's recognition of their importance.)

Miss Sills, along with other great artists in our country, including Van Cliburn, who is a guest this evening, serve with great distinction on our National Council.

I have been told by a great authority on this subject, our Vice President, that when he was Governor of the state of New York, that he would talk for hours



to legislators about the arts. Admittedly there was some understanding of his views, but when Beverly swept into the halls of Albany with her persuasive arguments, there was immediate understanding -- and the vote was overwhelming. Hers is a voice of greatest beauty -- it is also a voice of great impact.

I think, perhaps, Beverly, that you might direct your attention to the Hill in Washington, as well as to the one in Albany. Both Nelson and I need your help. In the meantime, Betty and I are so grateful you would help us honor our wonderful friends.
