Funds to Fight Racism, Sexism

The Council on Interracial Books for Children (CIBC) has announced the award of a grant of \$300,000 from the Carnegie Corporation of New York to develop a resource and publication center on racism and sexism in education.

The proposed center would provide a number of services for teachers, librarians and parents. Most important will be annual evaluations and ratings of children's books on minority and feminist themes and the evaluation of social studies texts and basic readers for what the CIBC calls "degree of racism, sexism, and other distortions of human values." The evaluations will be published yearly as a reference for educators and publishers.

The center also is expected to develop and distribute bibliographies, lesson plans, teaching strategies and syllabi designed to eliminate racist and sexist stereotypes.

The idea for the new center developed from an earlier Carnegie-financed project of the CIBC that formulated criteria, to be published shortly, for identifying subtle manifestations of racism and sexism in recently published textbooks. As part of this project, the CIBC held a series of workshops at major universities to help teachers identify the stereotypes in their own textbooks.

The council's current activities are focused on its publication "The Bulletin," which until now has emphasized issues of particular interest to children's librarians but expects to expand its scope to include articles on aspects of racism and sexism relevant to classroom teachers. Planned subjects for future articles include racism in IQ and achievement testing and on successful strategies for increasing student understanding of racism and sexism.

Monday, March 22. Mrs. Ford will attend/host a luncheon for the members of the Committee for the Preservation of the White House. The luncheon will be held in the Red and Blue Rooms. Sherry will be served at 12:30, the luncheon follows at 1:00. Please note: There should be no press announcement or mention either before or afterwards. Maria is handling the luncheon. Clem Conger will handle their ensuing meeting.

Tuesday, March 23. North Carolina primary and the hope/prospect of a sixth consecutive win.

Wednesday, March 24. At 12:00 Mrs. Ford will participate in launching the new Congressional Club Cookbook at the Congressional Club on New Hampshire Avenue. She does not plan to stay long, but she has long been a member of the Club and has witnessed the launching of many cookbooks. Pete has the advance on this. That evening the Ford's will have private dinner guests.

Thursday, March 25. Mrs. Ford will join Fay Wells, as she has for many years, as Fay's personal guests for the Radio and TV Correspondents Dinner at the Washington Hilton. The President will also attend, but will dine in the Main Ballroom. This is a cross between a private and official event for Mrs. Ford. Pete has the advance.

Saturday, March 27. Mrs. Ford will attend the Helen Reddy concert at Constitution Hall at 10:30 p.m. for the benefit of ERAmerica. Susan and Jack had thought they might also attend, but both now think they will be out of town. There will be a reception following which Mrs. Ford will not attend. The President will be returning that night from his California/Wisconsin trip. Peter has the advance.
