Enclosed you will find samples of our regular vinyl
and our vinyl vent.

I strongly recommend one of the vinyl vents such as
440, 441, 442, 452, 453 or 455. Personally, I
believe the 440 or possibly the 453 would make the
best looking cushions. The advantage of the vinyl
vent is that if someone sits on the product with a
wet suit or in case of rain or in the event of a sudden
shower, the cushions would dry much more readily.

We will need to know the exact shipping instructions.
Please advise.

We will expedite this as much as possible. We're
thrilled with the opportunity to beautify the pool area.
