Internal Transfer Within GSA of the Office of Presidential Materials

Following up on our conversation yesterday concerning the internal GSA transfer of the Office of Presidential Materials to the National Archives, I spoke with Irwin Goldbloom. It is his feeling that this transfer would be positively perceived in the context of the removal of political considerations from the handling of these papers, without altering the role you currently exercise in controlling their release. Congressman Brademas has recently expressed some concern over this political factor and is considering holding hearings on GSA's revised regulations. Thus, a transfer could have positive effects. To the extent someone might criticize this transfer as a change in the status quo, Irwin believes that such charges would be unsubstantiated, but in any event could be minimized by waiting until the Three-Judge District Court has ruled before announcing this transfer.

GSA does not require an immediate decision on this proposal. However, I have advised Jack Eckerd's office that you may wish to discuss this matter with him. Incidentally, this does not mean that Tom Wolf would automatically discontinue his present responsibilities.
