The San Diego Yacht Club has established the San Diego to Manzanillo International Yacht Race to replace the San Diego to Acapulco Regatta which was originally founded in 1952. The inaugural race for this biennial, international regatta starts off San Diego Bay, January 31, 1976.

The San Diego to Manzanillo Regatta is considered to be the premier international racing event on the west coast and the goodwill generated between the two countries is immeasurable.

It has been necessary to establish an entirely new trophy structure for this truly outstanding international event. Our Mexican Race Liason Chairman in Mexico has secured the donation, on behalf of the President of Mexico, of a perpetual trophy to be presented to the overall winner of this regatta. This overall winner trophy is to be known as "The Presidents Trophy."
