- 4. Barnett Samuels, club's president, who will call for revival of GOP spirit, etc., and introduce the VP.
  - 5. The Vice President

(Seated at head table: ex-Sen. Leverett Saltonstall, xex.-Rep. Larry Curtis, ex-Rep. Hastings Keith, Rep. Silvio Conte, Rep. Peggy Hechler, Bill Weeks, Governor Sargent, Rep. Paul Cronin (freshman), Lloyd Warning (ex-National Committee member, conservative, noted fund-raiser) Sen. Brooke not coming.
