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BROTHERHOOD COMMISSION OF THE SOUTHERN BAPTIST CONVENTION CHAMMED DALLAS, TEXAS, FRIDAY, JUNE 14, 1974

I AM HONORED TO BE HERE TODAY AT THE INVITATION OF THE

BROTHERHOOD COMMISSION OF THE SOUTHERN BAPTIST CONVENTION.

SINCE THIS MEETING IS TO SET THE STAGE FOR YOUR DISCUSSION OF PLANS FOR GREATER INVOLVEMENT BY LAYMEN, I FEEL A STRONG SENSE OF IDENTITY. MY OLDEST SON IS A THEOLOGY STUDENT AND I AM NOT. BUT I FIND MYSELF CALLED UPON TO ADDRESS VARIOUS RELIGIOUS GROUPS. IT WOULD APPEAR THAT GOD HAS GIVEN EVERYONE A ROLE TO PLAY IN HIS SERVICE.

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I WANT TO TALK TO YOU THIS MORNING ABOUT WHAT'S RIGHT IN OUR COUNTRY. WE HAVE HEARD SO MUCH ABOUT WHAT'S WRONG, THE TIME HAS COME TO TAKE A MORE POSITIVE LOOK -- A NEW ASSESSMENT OF OUR POTENTIAL FOR HUMAN GROWTH.

OUR GOOD FRIEND, BROOKS HAYS OF ARKANSAS, WHO SERVED AS MY COLLEAGUE IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, AND WHO WAS PRESIDENT OF THIS GREAT CONVENTION YOU REPRESENT, HAS INFORMED ME THAT THE SOUTHERN BAPTIST CONVENTION IS THE LARGEST PROTESTANT DENOMINATION IN THE UNITED STATES. I MIGHT ADD THAT IT IS EVEN THE LARGEST IN TEXAS.



THE SOUTHERN BAPTISTS TODAY MAINTAIN CHURCHES IN EVERY STATE OF THE UNION AND THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA. YOU HAVE COME A LONG WAY FROM THE TIME WHEN BAPTIST MINISTERS WERE IMPRISONED FOR PREACHING THE GOSPEL IN VIRGINIA, BAPTISTS WERE A MINORITY GROUP... YET NO DENOMINATION GAVE MORE FERVENT SUPPORT TO THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION THAN THE BAPTIST PATRIOTS OF VIRGINIA.

AMONG THEM WERE MEN LIKE JOHN LELAND, A BAPTIST PREACHER. AND, I AM PLEASED TO NOTE, THE VIRGINIA BAPTISTS HAD A FORD IN THEIR PAST IN THE PERSON OF REUBEN FORD, AN ASSOCIATE OF LELAND.

BAPTISTS HAD NO HESITANCY IN EQUATING THEIR STRUGGLE

FOR RELIGIOUS FREEDOM WITH THE ONE FOR POLITICAL FREEDOM IN WHICH THE COLONIES WERE ENGAGED. WHEN VIRGINIA ADOPTED ITS OWN CONSTITUTION IN 1776, IT CONTAINED A GUARANTEE FOR FULL RELIGIOUS FREEDOM FOR ALL --- A TRIBUTE TO THE WORK OF BAPTISTS. JOHN LELAND OWNED A FARM NEIGHBORING THAT OF

JAMES MADISON. HE URGED MADISON TO INTRODUCE A SET OF RESOLUTIONS IN OUR FIRST CONGRESS TO GRANT MORE EXPLICIT RIGHTS TO THE CITIZENS OF THE NEW NATION. MY CO-RELIGIONISTS, THE EPISCOPALIANS, BEING INTELLIGENT PEOPLE, BY THAT TIME SAW THE LIGHT. THEY JOINED THE BAPTISTS AND OTHERS IN BACKING CONGRESSMAN JAMES MADISON'S RESOLUTIONS. THE MADISON PROPOSALS WERE ACCEPTED AND BECAME THE FIRST 10 AMENDMENTS OF OUR CONSTITUTION. THE FIRST AMENDMENT, OF COURSE, PROVIDES THAT "CONGRESS CHALL MAKE NO LAW RESPECTING AN ESTABLISHMENT OF RELIGION, NOR PROHIBITING THE FREE EXERCISE THEREOF..."



IN THOSE VERY FIRST WORDS OF THE FIRST AMENDMENT, WE FIND THE CHARTER OF RELIGIOUS LIBERTY IN AMERICA. ACROSS AMERICA RESOUNDED THE WORDS OF THE OLD HYMN, "FAITH OF OUR FATHERS LIVING STILL." IT WAS OUT OF THAT KIND OF FAITH THAT OUR NATION GREW STRONG. AS THE NATION GREW, SO DID THE BAPTIST CHURCH. YOUR SIMPLE AND DIRECT MESSAGE YOUR HUMILITY AND CONVICTION, PROVIDED A CLEAR AND RESOUNDING TRUMPET. FOR WHO WOULD HAVE JOINED THE RANKS AND PERPETUATED THE FAITH IF YOU HAD SOUNDED AN UNCERTAIN TRUMPET.

THE CONCEPT OF SALVATION RELATES TO AWAKENING AND CHANGE. I THINK THE TIME HAS COME FOR OUR ENTIRE NATION TO HEAR THE VIBRANT NOTES OF A VERY CERTAIN TRUMPET CALL -- A CALL TO REAFFIRM THE VALUES THAT HAVE MADE THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA THE GREATEST NATION IN THE WORLD, A NATION WITH MORE FREEDOM, MORE OPPORTUNITY, AND MORE BELSSINGS. WE ALSO FACE MORE CHALLENGES AND IT IS IN RESPONSE TO THAT CALL TO ACTION THAT YOU HAVE ASSEMBLED HERE IN DALLAS.



I AM DELIGHTED TO LEARN OF THE NEW INVOLVEMENT OF THE BAPTIST LAITY IN MISSION ACTION IN YOUR VARIOUS COMMUNITIES AND IN RESPONSIBILITIES THAT GO BEYOND THE CHURCH INTO THE AREA OF PUBLIC SERVICE. THE LAYMAN OF THE BAPTIST CHURCH IS BECOMING NOT JUST A LISTENER ON SUNDAY BUT A DOER EVERY DAY OF THE WEEK. AND I CANNOT TELL YOU HOW IMPORTANT IT IS TO EXPAND YOUR INVOLVEMENT, TO BROADEN YOUR CONSCIOUSNESS, AND TO INTENSIFY YOUR COMMITMENT TO YOUR COMMUNITY AND TO YOUR NATION.



THE CHURCH HAS COME TO THE REALIZATION THAT THE JOB IS TOO BIG FOR THE CLERGY TO DO ALONE. THERE IS MORE THAN A SUNDAY KIND OF FAITH, I HOPE THAT MANY MORE BAPTISTS OF THE CALIBER OF MY FRIEND, JOHN BUCHANAN, FIND THEIR WAY INTO POLITICS AND BECOME INVOLVED, BRINGING WITH THEM A NEW SENSE OF MORALITY AND PURPOSE. LAY PEOPLE OF ALL CHURCHES MUST SEE THE BROADER NEED TO APPLY THEIR FAITH WHERE IT COUNTS. WHEN THE LAITY MOVES OUT OF THE PEWS TO MEET THE REAL PROBLEMS OF OUR FELLOW MAN, THEN TRULY WILL THE FAITH OF OUR FATHERS BECOME A LIVING FAITH.



THE BUREAU OF SOCIAL SCIENCE RESEARCH REPORTS THAT A MAJORITY OF AMERICANS FEEL THAT RELIGION IS LOSING ITS INFLUENCE ON OUR WAY OF LIFE. I PERSONALLY DON'T AGREE WITH THIS CONCLUSION, BUT IF IT IS EVEN HALF TRUE, THE TIME HAS COME TO REVIVE THAT INFLUENCE. THE PROPHETS OF DOOM AND GLOOM HAVE WRITTEN A SELF-FULFILLING SCENARIO OF THE DECLINE AND FALL OF THE AMERICAN REPUBLIC.



WE NEED A NEW SORT OF FAITH WHICH IS FAR OLDER THAN OUR NATION. I REFER TO THE PROPHETIC VISION OF THE HOLY BIBLE AND THE WORD THAT JESUS CHRIST IS THE MEDIATOR BETWEEN GOD AND MAN. WE READ IN LUKE: "JESUS SAID UNTO HIM, RECEIVE THY SIGHT: THY FAITH HATH SAVED THEE."



WE ARE CALLED UPON IN HOLY WRIT TO "STAND FAST THEREFORE IN THE LIBERTY WHEREWITH CHRIST HATH MADE US FREE." HOW DO WE APPLY THIS TO THE REUNIFICATION OF OUR NATIONAL SPIRIT, THE RESTORATION OF OUR MORALE AS A PEOPLE, AND THE INSPIRATION TO REDEEM AND RENEW ALL THAT IS BEAUTIFUL AND GOOD ABOUT AMERICA?

WE MUST ACT BY CHOOSING. GOD SPEAKS TO US THROUGH THE BIBLE AND SAYS THAT "I HAVE SET BEFORE YOU LIFE AND DEATH, BLESSING AND CURSING: THEREFORE CHOOSE LIFE, THAT BOTH THOU AND THY SEED MAY LIVE." AMERICA NOW STANDS AT A CRUCIAL MOMENT OF DECISION. WE CAN SURRENDER TO ANARCHY AND AGONY. OR WE CAN REJECT NEGATIVE THINKING AND GET OURSELVES TOGETHER TO MOVE FORWARD TO A HIGHER STATE OF MORAL RESPONSIBILITY AND ACHIEVEMENT.



LAYMEN OF YOUR CHURCH AND OF ALL FAITHS CAN HELP GENERATE A HEALING SPIRIT OF LOVE, COOPERATION AND UNDERSTANDING THAT CAN SWEEP THIS NATION OUT OF THE DEPRESSIVE CONDITION THAT AFFLICTS TOO MANY OF OUR PEOPLE. I ENVISAGE A SORT OF DIVINE CONSCIOUSNESS IN WHICH THE POWER OF GOD IS PERSONALLY EXPERIENCED BY THE INDIVIDUAL WHO CHOOSES TO INVOLVE HIMSELF POSITIVELY WITH HIS COMMUNITY AND NATION. TO THE INDIVIDUAL WILL COME A UNIFICATION OF MIND, BODY, AND SPIRIT. TO THE NATION WILL COME A NEW AWARENESS OF THE DIVINE PRESENCE.

ONE DOES NOT HAVE TO BE A THEOLOGIAN TO RESPOND TO THE PRESENCE OF GOD. MAN BECOMES WHAT HE THINKS UPON. THERE ARE ENOUGH MEN AND WOMEN OF FAITH IN THE UNITED STATES TO THINK SPIRITUALLY AND TO THINK AFFIRMATIVELY AND TO PREVENT US FROM HAVING A NATIONAL NERVOUS BREAKDOWN AS THE FAINT OF HEART FEAR. WE CAN TRANSCEND. WE CAN CHANGE. WE CAN GROW. AND WE CAN INSPIRE OTHERS BY OUR EXAMPLE.



WE MEET THIS MORNING WHEN OUR PRESIDENT IS IN THE AREA OF THE HOLY LAND. REGARDLESS OF OUR VIEWS ON POLITICAL CONTROVERSIES IN WASHINGTON, THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES SPEAKS FOR ALL OF US WHEN HE SEEKS PEACE ABROAD. BLESSED IS THE PEACEMAKER. THE PROVERBS TELL US THAT "WHEN A MAN'S WAYS PLEASE THE LORD, HE MAKETH EVEN HIS ENEMIES TO BE AT PEACE WITH HIM."



I FEEL IT APPROPRIATE TO OBSERVE THAT OUR PRESIDENT AND HIS SECRETARY OF STATE ARE ON A SACRED MISSION IN THAT REGION WHERE THE SON OF GOD OFFERED THE SERMON ON THE MOUNT. IT IS AN AREA WHERE THOSE KINDRED PEOPLES, THE JEWS AND ARABS, HAVE SUFFERED THE TORMENT OF RELENTLESS WARS AND WHERE THE SUPERPOWERS OF THE WORLD HAVE COME TO THE BRINK OF ARMAGEDDON. IF PEACE CAN NOW BE BROUGHT FORTH FROM THE CRUEL CARNAGE OF SO MANY YEARS, WHO IS TO SAY THAT A DIVINE PRESENCE IS NOT AGAIN INVOLVED?

PRESIDENT NIXON INNOVATED A BOLD AND COURAGEOUS FOREIGN POLICY THAT HISTORY WILL CREDIT IN DUE PERSPECTIVE. IT WAS PRESIDENT NIXON WHO DESIGNATED SECRETARY OF STATE KISSINGER, A MAN OF THE FAITH OF THE OLD TESTAMENT, WHO HAS BROUGHT FORTH MODERN MIRACLES. THE DETRACTORS OF THESE TWO MEN WOULD DO WELL TO DWELL ON THE HIGH PURPOSE THAT THE PRESIDENT AND THE SECRETARY OF STATE ARE PURSUING AS EMISSARIES OF PEACE, LET US ALL PRAY FOR THEIR SUCCESS. AND I KNOW THAT YOU SHARE MY FAITH THAT THEY CAN AND MUST SUCCEED.

THE TORMENTED PEOPLES OF THE MIDDLE EAST TURNED TO US AND TRUSTED US. THEY TURNED TO NO OTHER NATION OF THE WORLD TO ACT AS THE MEDIATOR OF PEACE. THIS FILLS ME WITH PRIDE ----RENEWED PRIDE ---- IN BEING AN AMERICAN.

I AM ALSO PROUD THAT OUR PRESIDENT HAS VENTURED TO THE FAR CORNERS OF THIS EARTH IN PURSUIT OF PEACE. HE HAS ESTABLISHED AN ENTIRELY NEW RELATIONSHIP WITH THE SOVIET UNION AND THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA. HE HAS EXTRICATED OUR ARMED FORCES FROM THE WAR IN VIETNAM AND LIBERATED OUR PRISONERS OF WAR. HE HAS BROUGHT US TO THE THRESHOLD OF A NEW ERA IN WORLD AFFAIRS.



# PRESIDENT NIXON HAS THE FAITH TO BELIEVE IN

TRANSFORMATION FROM WAR TO PEACE. WE AT HOME SHOULD HAVE THE FAITH TO BELIEVE IN HIS MISSION. I ASK THIS MORNING THAT THIS NATION STRENGTHEN HIS HAND WHEN HE IS ABROAD ON HIGH PURPOSE. LET POLITICS AND CONTROVERSY STOP AT THE WATER'S EDGE.

IF AMERICA IS TO BE TRANSFORMED, TO MOVE AHEAD AT HOME AND ABROAD --- AND I HAVE FAITH THAT IT IS --- WE MUST LISTEN FOR THAT CERTAIN TRUMPET. AND IF WE LISTEN WE WILL HEAR A FAMILIAR CALL. IT WILL BE A CALL TO THE OLD VIRTUES OF RESPECT FOR THE HUMAN INDIVIDUAL, OF REVERENCE FOR THE CREATOR OF US ALL OF LOVE AND REDEMPTION OF THE FAMILY, AND OF A ZEAL TO ATTACK AGGRESSIVELY THE GREAT PROBLEMS OF OUR TIMES. IT WILL ALSO SUMMON US TO RENEW OUR UNCONQUERABLE FAITH IN THE FUTURE OF OUR BELOVED COUNTRY, THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

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#### REMARKS BY VICE PRESIDENT GERALD R. FORD BROTHERHOOD COMMISSION OF THE SOUTHERN BAPTIST CONVENTION DALLAS, TEXAS JUNE 14, 1974

#### FOR RELEASE AT 7:30 A.M. FRIDAY

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I am honored to be here today at the invitation of the Brotherhood Commission of the Southern Baptist Convention.

Since this meeting is to set the stage for your discussion of plans for greater involvement by laymen, I feel a strong sense of identity. My oldest son is a theology student and I am not. But I find myself called upon to address various religious groups. It would appear that God has given everyone a role to play in His service.

I want to talk to you this morning about what's right in our country. We have heard so much about what's wrong, the time has come to take a more positive look -- a new assessment of our potential for human growth.

Our good friend, Brooks Hays of Arkansas, who served as my colleague in the House of Representatives, and who was president of this great convention you represent, has informed me that the Southern Baptist Convention is the largest Protestant denomination in the United States. I might add that it is even the largest in Texas.

The Southern Baptists today maintain churches in every State of the Union and the District of Columbia. You have come a long way from the time when Baptist ministers were imprisoned for preaching the Gospel in Virginia. Baptists were a minority group. Yet no denomination gave more fervent support to the American Revolution than the Baptist patriots of Virginia.

Among them were men like John Leland, a Baptist preacher. And, I am pleased to note, the Virginia Baptists had a Ford in their past in the person of Reuben Ford, an associate of Leland.

Baptists had no hesitancy in equating their struggle for religious freedom with the one for political freedom in which the colonies were engaged. When Virginia adopted its own Constitution in 1776, it contained a guarantee for full religious freedom for all — a tribute to the work of Baptists.

John Leland owned a farm neighboring that of James Madison. He urged Madison to introduce a set of resolutions in our first Congress to grant more explicit rights to the citizens of the new Nation. My co-religionists, the

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Episcopalians, being intelligent people, by that time saw the light. They joined the Baptists and others in backing Congressman James Madison's resolutions. The Madison proposals were accepted and became the first 10 amendments of our Constitution.

The First Amendment, of course, provides that "Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, nor prohibiting the free exercise thereof..."

In those very first words of the First Amendment, we find the charter of religious liberty in America. Across America resounded the words of the old hymn, "Faith of Our Fathers Living Still." It was out of that kind of faith that our Nation grew strong. As the Nation grew, so did the Baptist Church. Your simple and direct message, your humility and conviction, provided a clear and resounding trumpet. For who would have joined the ranks and perpetuated the faith if you had sounded an uncertain trumpet.

The concept of salvation relates to awakening and change. I think the time has come for our entire Nation to hear the vibrant notes of a very certain trumpet call — a call to reaffirm the values that have made the United States of America the greatest Nation in the world, a Nation with more freedom, more opportunity, and more blessings. We also face more challenges and it is in response to that call to action that you have assembled here in Dallas.

I am delighted to learn of the new involvement of the Baptist laity in mission action in your various communities and in responsibilities that go beyond the church into the area of public service. The layman of the Baptist Church is becoming not just a listener on Sunday but a doer every day of the week. And I cannot tell you how important it is to expand your involvement, to broaden your consciousness, and to intensify your commitment to your community and to your Nation.

The church has come to the realization that the job is too big for the clergy to do alone. There is more than a Sunday kind of faith. I hope that many more Baptists of the caliber of my friend, John Buchanan, find their way into politics and become involved, bringing with them a new sense of morality and purpose. Lay people of all churches must see the broader need to apply their faith where it counts. When the laity moves out of the pews to meet the real problems of our fellow men, then truly will the Faith of our Fathers become a living faith.

The Bureau of Social Science Research reports that a majority of Americans feel that religion is losing its influence on our way of life. I personally don't agree with this conclusion, but if it is even half true, the time has come to revive that influence. The prophets of doom and gloom have

written a self-fulfilling scenario of the decline and fall of the American Republic. We need a new sort of faith which is far older than our Nation. I refer to the prophetic vision of the Holy Bible and the word that Jesus Christ is the mediator between God and man. We read in Luke: "Jesus said unto him, Receive thy sight: thy faith hath saved thee."

We are called upon in Holy writ to "stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free." How do we apply this to the reunification of our National spirit, the restoration of our morale as a people, and the inspiration to redeem and renew all that is beautiful and good about America?

We must act by choosing. God speaks to us through the Bible and says that "I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live." America now stands at a crucial moment of decision. We can surrender to anarchy and agony. Or we can reject negative thinking and get ourselves together to move forward to a higher state of moral responsibility and achievement.

Laymen of your church and of all faiths can help generate a healing spirit of love, cooperation and understanding that can sweep this Nation out of the depressive condition that afflicts too many of our people. I envisage a sort of Divine consciousness in which the power of God is personally experienced by the individual who chooses to involve himself positively with his community and Nation. To the individual will come a unification of mind, body, and spirit. To the Nation will come a new awareness of the divine presence.

One does not have to be a theologian to respond to the presence of God. Man becomes what he thinks upon. There are enough men and women of faith in the United States to think spiritually and to think affirmatively and to prevent us from having a national nervous breakdown as the faint of heart fear. We can transcend. We can change. We can grow. And we can inspire others by our example

We meet this morning when our President is in the area of the Holy Land. Regardless of our views on political controversies in Washington, the President of the United States speaks for all of us when he seeks peace abroad. Blessed is the peacemaker. The Proverbs tell us that "when a man's ways please the Lord, He maketh even his enemies to be at peace with him."

I feel it appropriate to observe that our President and his Secretary of State are on a sacred mission in that region where the son of God offered the Sermon on the Mount. It is an area where those kindred peoples, the Jews and Arabs, have suffered the torment of relentless wars and where the superpowers of the world have come to the brink of Armageddon. If peace can now be brought

forth from the cruel carnage of so many years, who is to say that a divine presence is not again involved?

President Nixon innovated a bold and courageous foreign policy that history will credit in due perspective. It was President Nixon who designated Secretary of State Kissinger, a man of the faith of the Old Testament, who has brought forth modern miracles. The detractors of these two men would do well to dwell on the high purpose that the President and the Secretary of State are pursuing as emissaries of peace. Let us all pray for their success. And I know that you share my faith that they can and must succeed.

The tormented peoples of the Middle East turned to us and trusted us. They turned to no other Nation of the world to act as the mediator of peace. This fills me with pride — renewed pride — in being an American.

I am also proud that our President has ventured to the far corners of this earth in pursuit of peace. He has established an entirely new relationship with the Soviet Union and the People's Republic of China. He has extricated our armed forces from the war in Vietnam and liberated our prisoners of war. He has brought us to the threshold of a new era in world affairs.

President Nixon has the faith to believe in transformation from war to peace. We at home should have the faith to believe in his mission. I ask this morning that this Nation strengthen his hand when he is abroad on high purpose. Let politics and controversy stop at the water's edge.

If America is to be transformed, to move ahead at home and abroad -- and I have faith that it is -- we must listen for that certain trumpet. And if we listen we will hear a familiar call. It will be a call to the old virtues of respect for the human individual, of reverence for the Creator of us all, of love and redemption of the family, and of a zeal to attack aggressively the great problems of our times. It will also summon us to renew our unconquerable faith in the future of our beloved country, the United States of America.

President Nixon innovated a bold and courageous foreign policy that history will credit in due perspective . It will be a call to the old virtues of respect for the human individual, of revenue for the Creator of us all, of love and redemption of the family, and of a familiar to attack aggressively the great problems of our times . It will also summon m unconquerable faith in the future of our beloved country, the United States of America .

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
