BACKGROUND:

Upon arrival at Andrews Air Force Base, there will be a brief, informal welcoming ceremony. You will be met by Mrs. Ford, Janet Ford, 12 members of the Cabinet, approximately 7 members of Congress and four members of the Diplomatic Corps. Also on hand will be base personnel, White House staff, and their families.

You will deliver a brief arrival statement prior to boarding the helicopter en route the South Grounds.

Weather forecast: 20 percent chance of rain, partly cloudy, temperature in the mid 50's.


