I talked to George Meany this afternoon, and he has no objection to participating in the Labor meeting even though Peter Brennan also participates. However, he cannot attend a meeting on the 10th, the presently scheduled date. He can attend on the 6th, 11th, or 12th. The 11th is the preferable date. Your schedule is free then and Congress will have reconvened.
