MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

SUBJECT: HEW Budget Amendment Request

HEW is urging that you send to the Congress a budget request to fund H.R. 69 (the elementary and secondary education bill you signed last week) that exceeds the original FY 1975 budget by \$59 million in budget authority (\$37 million in outlays) and provides for FY 1976 forward funding \$124 million above the budget.

The attached memorandum and supporting materials have been jointly prepared by OMB and HEW staff; setting out the arguments for and against breaking the budget for this purpose.

In summary, Acting Secretary Carlucci recommends you approve higher levels of funding for these programs; I recommend against.
