- TO: Rep. Bill Frenzel (R-Minn)
- PURPOSE: To discuss campaign reform.
- DATE: Call should be made just prior to meeting today at 4:00 p. m. with Rep. Wayne Hays (D-Ohio).
- BACKGROUND:
1. Frenzel is Republican Chairman of the Task Force on Campaign Reform and is one of the GOP's most articulate spokesmen on issue.
 2. Frenzel recommended the President meet with Hays but had asked for a private meeting beforehand to recommend an approach to the Democratic chairman.
 3. Because of scheduling problems, Frenzel can be telephoned for his advice.
