Following your request that the top women appointees assist me in identifying key women for possible appointments, my staff has been compiling the many suggestions from these women.

I have met with Bill Scranton and given him a list of top women for possible Cabinet and Sub-Cabinet positions. We are continuing to develop lists of women for possible appointments to lower echelon positions and to Commissions and Boards.

The expectations of women are very high, and we will continue to assist you in every way we can to facilitate these appointments.
