FROM: William E. Timmons
SUBJECT: Senate votes

The Senate vetoed your federal pay deferral today by a vote of 64-35 (our vote was 27 Republicans and 8 Democrats). Senator Mansfield voted for you.

We had about eight more votes if we were close enough to win. (Packwood, Long, etc.)

The fourth cloture on consumer protection failed 64-34.
