Based on present information, all members of the Arizona Congressional delegation plan to be in Arizona on the 21st. Therefore, we anticipate no travel requirements to Arizona. It is recommended that all members of the Arizona Congressional delegation be invited, along with Governor Williams, to greet the President at the arrival at Davis-Monthan AFB. The members would be invited to be guests at the President's luncheon in Tubac for President Echeverria. In addition. they would be invited to form a special greeting committee to be introduced to President Echeverria at the departure ceremony.
