PURPOSE: To extend best wishes to the Ohio Farm Bureau Leadership meeting being held at the Columbus (Ohio) Downtown Sheraton Hotel

- BACKGROUND:
1. Representative Sam Devine (R-Ohio) requests the President make a brief (one or two minute) call to the meeting.
 2. Eighty-six Ohio Farm Bureau County presidents will be present.


