The approach of Christmas is reflected in your incoming mail with Christmas greetings and messages being the leading ground-gainer during the past week. About 7,279 have been received so far. Following that, the mail is distributed over a wide variety of issues and subjects.

Though the volume is relatively small (1,150 pieces), it is interesting to note that the mail on the A. T. & T. anti-trust suit is running 100 to 1 against the Justice Department action.

Several other small items of interest: Since becoming President you have received 11,000 requests for birthday and anniversary messages, 6,000 requests for your autographed photo, and about 5,000 requests for jobs or positions in your Administration.
