This morning I returned a call that Governor Meskill placed to you. The Governor said that Senators Scott and Weicker suggested that he call you to let you know he still wanted to see the confirmation process through. You have nominated him for a Court of Appeals judgeship.

He indicated:

- 1. He hopes the President will "stick with me."
- 2. He knows the confirmation has been held up to await completion of a legislative inquiry in Connecticut.
- 3. The legislatures inquiry is complete and he feels now he definitely was cleared of any wrongdoing. However, their report will not be ready until Congress has adjourned.
- 4. He hopes you will re-submit his name to the 94th Congress if his nomination lapses following the current session.
