Here are the energy figures you requested.

Of the total energy consumed in the United States in 1974, about 4 percent came from Arab countries and, from all of OPEC about 12 percent (Source: FEA). At the present time, about 25 percent of total crude imports come from Arab countries (OAPEC) and 75 percent from OPEC.

The percent increase of OPEC compared to total crude imports has been rising.

Figures for 1973 and 1974 are estimates. If you correct for the impact of the embargo, the figures would be: Jan. -Nov. 1973 -- 28 percent from OAPEC and 65 percent OPEC; last quarter 1974 -- 25 percent OAPEC and 75 percent OPEC. (Source: CIA, see attached.)

The percentage of total crude imports from OAPEC is expected to rise significantly because most of the oil surplus is in Arab countries.
