WOULD DEEPLY APPRECIATE YOUR SHOWING THE PRESIDENT THE FOLLOWING TELEGRAM WHICH I HAVE ALSO SHARED WITH SENATOR CURTIS "ON THE BASIS OF ADVISE THAT AL QUIE AND SECRETARY WEINBERGER HAD RECOMMENDED ROBERT EGBERT OF NEBRASKA FOR THE PRESIDENT'S CONSIDERATION FOR NOMINATION AS DIRECTOR OF THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF EDUCATION, I STRONGLY SUPPORTED EGBERT AND URGED LEADING EDUCATORS TO SUPPORT HIM. I NOW UNDERSTAND THAT THE PRESIDENT HAS INDICATED HE MAY NOT NOMINATE EGBERT. EGBERT IS A REPUBLICAN AND IS ABLE AND COMPETENT HE IS SUPPORTED BY SENATOR CURTIS AS A FORMER DEMOCRATIC SECRETARY OF HEW I PLEDGED TO SUPPORT EGBERT WITH SENATORS PELL AND MAGNUSON AND TO SUPPORT HIS NOMINATION BEFORE THE SENATE COMMITTEE". IN VIEW OF THE STRONG SUPPORT WHICH EGBERT HAS FROM EDUCATORS FROM ALL OVER THE NATION I HOPE THAT THE PRESIDENT WILL RECONSIDER AND NOMINATE EGBERT
