Speaker Albert and Minority Leader Rhodes have accepted an invitation extended by Secretary Kissinger to visit the Peoples Republic of China during Easter recess and we are working with the Speaker and John on the details. They will be gone from about March 26 to April 8.

Senator Humphrey is taking a delegation to NATO during that same period; Tip O'Neill has a group going to the Middle East at the same time, and Senator Sparkman has a trip planned to the Soviet Union during the Easter recess.
