SUBJECT: Defeat of the Humanitarian Aid to South Vietnam Bill
(H.R. 6090)

We lost 46 Republicans on the Conference Report defeat, many of them conservative, because of Bob Bauman's argument that money provided by the bill could be used to "feed the communists" via the relief authority through international organizations.
