MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

SUBJECT: Turkish Aid Vote

Attached is a tally on the votes for the 41-40 approval of the Turkish Aid bill today.

About ten of our votes were absent and several Senators who were supporting our position, if necessary, waited in the well and voted no after it appeared we had won.

Senator Kennedy then obtained unanimous consent to change his vote and this resulted in the one vote margin of victory.
