SUBJECT: Senator Lloyd Bentsen (D-Tex.)

Senator Bentsen tried to call the President this afternoon and we returned the call to see if we could help.

Bentsen had called to express his concern about the assassination attempt in San Francisco and to urge the President take all possible caution and indicated his deep concern about the President's well being. He also wanted to tell the President that he is strongly supportive of a phased de-control plan of any duration recommended by the President and will support the President in this effort.

If the President has the time I would recommend he phone Bentsen because of his Presidential candidacy, but a return call is not necessary if time doesn't permit.
