SUBJECT: Congressional Schedule for January

Rhodes, The Speaker, Mansfield and Scott have signed off on the following schedule if it is satisfactory to the President:

Monday, January 19 - The Congress convenes and the President delivers the State of the Union Address.

Tuesday, January 20 - The Budget is officially transmitted to Congress late on an embargoed basis. Press briefed on the Budget.

Wednesday - January 21 - The Budget released officially.
