SUBJECT: Tax Bill Veto Vote

Bob Michel urgently requests that the President call Congressman Sam Gibbons (D-Fla.) prior to 11 A.M. today to urge Gibbons support on sustaining the Tax Bill veto.

Michel believes that Gibbons is the key to 6 or 7 votes on the veto.

Congressman Herman Schneebeli recommends that the President call Phil Landrum prior to the 11 A.M. vote.

If the President has any time before 11 A.M. we recommend these two calls.
