DATE: Prior to the President's departure for New Hampshire on Thursday, February 19, 1976

PURPOSE To thank the Congressman for his assistance in New Hampshire

BACKGROUND Congressman McCloskey was in New Hampshire for three days last week campaigning. Since his return, he has generated numerous contacts with other moderate/liberal Republican Congressmen to enlist their support by making phone calls or personal appearances in New Hampshire in the President's behalf. The Congressman is returning to New Hampshire this weekend with up to 70 supporters of the President, some Congressmen, some private citizens, all of whom are going at their own expense to work in the phone banks, make appearances at forums, rallies, etc. All in all, Congressman McCloskey has done yeoman service on the President's behalf with very little urging from anyone.
